This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the Tuscaloosa County 2014 Hazard Mitigation Plan.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of invoices to Burk-Kleinpeter for engineering services on the following projects:

Old Fayette Road over Binion Creek tributary bridge replacement project	\$250.00
Holman Church Road bridge replacement project	\$1,200.00

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of invoice to Neel-Schaffer Engineering for engineering services on the following project:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the purchase of right-of-way for the following FEMA projects: Patrick Blackburn Road (0.447 acres) and Wire Road (0.394 acres).

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to post a speed limit of 35 MPH on Shore Lake Drive.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a Subdivision Regulation Waiver Request on Timbertop Estates, resurvey of Lots 25 and 26.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving a preliminary plat for Timbertop Estates, resurvey of lots 25 and 26.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a Subdivision Regulation Waiver Request on River Point Vista. County Attorney Robert Spence was directed to establish a letter with language stating the County will not make improvements or build a road to this property.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved and the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for May 2015.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the "Insolvents, Errors and Taxes in Litigation for 2014 and Uncollected Insolvents and Taxes in Litigation for Previous Years" report, as prepared by Tax Collector Peyton Cochrane.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 6814 Unity Road from the list of structures deemed to be public nuisances. It was noted by County Attorney Robert Spence that the property has been inspected and the owner has completed the necessary repairs.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a funding request in the amount of \$65,000.00 from the District 1 Discretionary fund to PARA for phase 2 of the Northside Park.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a funding request in the amount of \$13,215.00 from the District 2 Discretionary fund for the septic tank installation and engineering services for Miners Community Park and a water fountain.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to begin the condemnation process on the 525 Crescent Ridge Road and 4511 Highpoint Drive.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to post "No Trucks" on Patriot Parkway.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss vendors parking on the County right-of-way.

Commissioner Bobby Miller requested the Sheriff's Department ticket vendors parked on the county right-of-way, especially in the area of North Rosser Road and Highway 69 South.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle's motion to approve a funding request in the amount of \$5,913.00 to PARA for fencing at the Braughton Park basketball court was seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller. After discussion, Commissioner Bobby Miller withdrew his second to the motion. The motion was tabled.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to begin the condemnation process on the 4119 60<sup>th</sup> Court and 4241 60<sup>th</sup> Court.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, July 8, 2015.
