

## TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION

## MEETING

JULY 8, 2015

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to change the County Commission Meeting date of July 15, 2015 to be July 22, 2015.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to removed 11312 Athena Drive and 11318 Athena Drive from the demolition list. The Engineering Department completed the demolition of both structures.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution confirming Tuscaloosa County's participation in the 2015 "Back to School" Sales Tax Holiday which exempts certain "covered items" from the county sales and use tax beginning at 12:01 a.m. (CST) on Friday August 7, 2015, and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday August 9, 2015 (the first full weekend of August 2015) as authorized by Act 2006-574.

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum presented Tuscaloosa County Road Foreman Tim Nix a twenty-five year service pin and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a contract amendment on the Burk-Kleinpeter contract for design services on the Holman Church Road bridge replacement project totaling \$24,400.00. The design was changed by ALDOT after the initial survey and layout were complete.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a proposal from TTL for a hazardous material survey on the Old Birmingham Highway widening and resurfacing project in the amount of \$3,500.00.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt resolutions approving and accepting the following preliminary plat submissions:

The Estates at Million Dollar Lake

Hidden Valley addition to Tannehill Farms, Resurvey of Lot 25

Ernest Clayton Subdivision.

River Point Vista Subdivision was tabled pending further inspection.

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum opened bids for Geogrid material, the NRCS Creek Clean-up projects, and mosquito spray chemical. The bids for geogrid and mosquito spray chemical were referred to the County Engineer for evaluation.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to allow the County Engineer to evaluate and award the bid for the NCRS Creek Clean-up to the lowest bid meeting specifications. The bidding firms were Warrior & Associates, Inc. and Hall-Taylor Construction Co., Inc.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize McGiffert and Associates to begin the preliminary work involved on the Virginia Circle/Oakdale Elementary TAP project.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously authorizing Chairman W. Hardy McCollum to execute an agreement with ADECA on the amendment submitted on the Holt Senior Activity Center.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously authorizing Chairman W. Hardy McCollum to execute an agreement on the Mountain Brook Lane project whereby the City of Tuscaloosa will provide the materials for the project.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to complete drainage repairs and repaving at the Northside High School stadium.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$90,350.00 for the purchase and appraisal of the property adjacent to Evans Roshell Park. This is the site for the new Holt Senior Citizens Center.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$10,790.00 for fencing at the Evans Roshell baseball field.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$5,913.00 from the District 4 discretionary fund for fencing for the Braughton Park basketball court.
