This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum presented Tuscaloosa County Captain Gary Hood a twenty-five year service pin and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum presented Tuscaloosa County Chief Mapper John Bounds a twenty-five year service pin and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission on The Shoals of North River Subdivision.

Commissioner Stan Acker's motion to table the resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission on Selman Subdivision was unanimously approved by the Commission.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the following bids:

Reinforcing Steel for use in the construction of precast bridge components to O'Ferrell Rebar, Inc in the amount of \$34.50 CWT for a total bid cost of \$32,200.00

Welded Wire Reinforcing Mats for use in the construction of precast bridge components to Insteel Wire Products in the amount of \$39,894.97

The helicopter pad will need to be paved and marked appropriately.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to begin the condemnation process on a structure in Stillman Heights, 3527 29th St., Parcel # 3108331004005000.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to begin the condemnation process on a structure in Kings Acres, 6315 63rd Ave., Parcel # 3603071003007000.
