This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize condemnation of 4601 Culver Road.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of the following invoices:

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to post "No Parking" in the cul-de-sac on Sally Hamner Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a request for a thirty (30) day bond extension on Laurelwood Subdivision, Phase 7.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for June 2014.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a funding increase of \$800.00 in petty cash by the License Commissioner; \$500.00 to the Vance License Department Annex and \$300.00 to the Northport License Department Annex.

Commissioner Bobby Miller's motion, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, to increase the daily capacity at Eagle Bluff Landfill to 2,000 cubic yards per day was approved on a three-two vote with Commissioners' Jerry Tingle and Reginald Murray casting the NAY votes.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expansion request from Sam Wilson on North River Memorial Gardens, Phase II.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to close Johnny Shines Street on Saturday, August 30, 2014 for the Annual Johnny Shines Blues Festival.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to allow a 40 foot right-of-way on Westside Road in Griffin Ridge.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to waive the 50 foot requirement to use the prescriptive right-of-way on Howell Camp Road.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to install stop signs at the intersection of Jack Lunceford Drive and Middle Coaling Road creating a three-way stop.
