This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to change the regularly scheduled County Commission meetings for June, July, and August to meet as follows:

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum, on behalf of the County Commission, presented a resolution to Union Furniture Company for their 91 years of business in Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a subdivision regulation waiver request to Alberta City Tower Subdivision.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution accepting the streets and drainage structures located in dedicated street rights-of-way for maintenance by the Tuscaloosa County Engineering Department in the Kings Ridge Subdivision, Phase II, District III.

Upon request by Chief Financial Officer Bill Lamb, Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to extend the prior fiscal year funding request to the District Attorney's Office for up to \$225,000.00 in fiscal year 2018.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize demolition of the structure at 19418 Abernant Loop Road, determined to be public nuisance.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session at the conclusion of the regular meeting to discuss on-going litigation.

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum opened RFP proposals for audio/visual equipment in the Commission Chambers and turned them over to IT Director James Tullidge for review.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a funding request in the amount of \$12,500.00 each from the District I discretionary fund and the District IV discretionary fund (\$25,000.00 total) to the Sipse Valley Volunteer Fire Department to match funds to purchase a new service/brush truck.

The Commission retired into Executive Session.

Following Executive Session, Chairman W. Hardy McCollum called the Commission back to order.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Attorney to file suit for damages in regard to a wreck involving Process Server Randy Wicker.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, June 27, 2018.
