This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Clarence Gary to the Indian Rivers Mental Health Board. His term will expire April 1, 2020.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize settlement of litigation regarding Kennedy Pasture in the amount of \$4,000.00.
