Commissioner Bobby Miller's motion to authorize funding for two relocation projects of Englewood-Hulls Water System, Inc., replacement of a water line in Marion Oaks Subdivision in the amount of \$43,500.00 and replacement of a water line on Kings Loop Road in the amount of \$8,900.00, was seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray. Commissioner Gary Youngblood's motion to amend to fund only the project on Kings Loop Road was not accepted by Commissioner Bobby Miller. Commissioner Bobby Miller's original motion to fund both projects was approved unanimously on a three-to-one vote, with Commissioner Gary Youngblood casting the NAY vote.

The committee will consist of two County Commissioners, County Administrator Melvin Vines, County Attorney Robert Spence, and Solid Waste Director Jim Patrie.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the replacement of the one-lane wooden bridge on Hemphill Road and for County Attorney Robert Spence to acquire right-of-way to proceed with condemnation if necessary.



There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 15, 2010.







WHEREAS, the bids have been tabulated and reviewed by the Project Engineer and the recommendation of award has been received;



RE: Bridge replacement on Hemphill Road.


Dear Commissioner Murry,

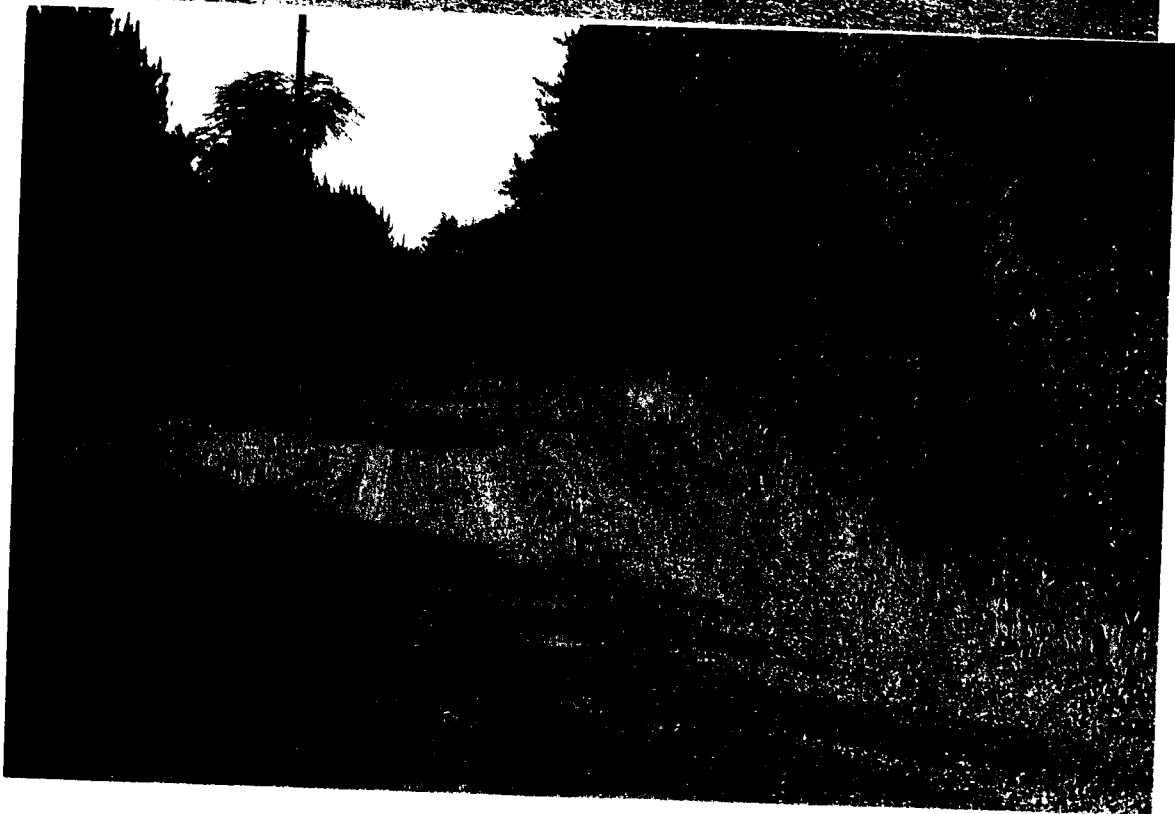
