This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment to Burk-Kleinpeter for engineering services on the Lye Branch Bridge Replacement Project in the amount of \$4,500.00.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the annual bid for metal pipe (full-coated and non-coated) and concrete pipe to Harvey Culvert Company, contingent upon said bidder providing the County with a performance bond. If Harvey Culvert Company fails to provide the performance bond, the second low bidder will be awarded the bid.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a supplemental agreement with Shirley Concrete Co., Inc., to add Type N curb and safety nose for a median on Patriot Parkway at a cost of \$35,400.00.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize a request from Almon Associates for a temporary construction easement on the Tuscaloosa Public Library property for the City of Tuscaloosa in conjunction with the construction on the City Riverwalk Phase III Project, contingent upon concurrence with the Tuscaloosa Public Library Board.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment to Sentell Engineering, Inc., for construction engineering on the Patriot Parkway Sidewalk/Lighting Project in the amount of \$12,987.78.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Change Order No. 2 in the amount of \$689.27 for contractor Hall-Taylor Construction Company, Inc., to clean and repair a damaged pipe in conjunction with the Patriot Parkway Sidewalk/Lighting Project.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize execution of a notice of award of construction contract to Hall-Taylor Construction Company, Inc., for the Northside Schools Sidewalk/Lighting Project, following concurrence with the Alabama Department of Transportation.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to pass a continuing resolution to allow the County to continue to operate under the existing 2009-2010 budget pending adoption of the 2010-2011 budget.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss payment to property owners Eugene H. Burrows and Joyce E. Burrows for right-of-way acquisition on Kitchens Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to pay property owners Eugene H. Burrows and Joyce E. Burrows, who accepted the appraised value of \$13,228.00 for right-of-way acquisition on Kitchens Road.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to begin condemnation proceedings on property located on Sand Road owned by Melvin L. Vines failed for lack of a second.

Bids for a storage array were opened and referred to the County IT Department for appropriate action. Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineering Department to expand the outside basketball court area at Walker Elementary School, as well as construct necessary drainage improvements, basing, and paving with plant mix at an estimated cost of \$7,000.00, pending a request letter from the County School Board.

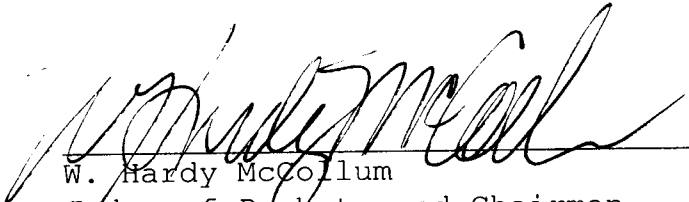
Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineering Department to assist with milling the existing paved area between the Samantha Volunteer Fire Department and Northside Road, to include repairing the rutted area and resurface with plant mix at an estimated material and contractor cost of \$10,000.00.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineering Department to assist the Carroll's Creek Water Authority with the construction of a water tank site at the intersection of Lary Lake Road and Firehouse Road, to include clearing, grubbing, disposing of the vegetative debris, grading the site, constructing an access road, and installing erosion control measures at an estimated cost of \$12,000.00 for materials.


Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to begin condemnation proceedings to obtain right-of-way needed for the Engineering Department to replace the bridge on Joe Taylor Road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the acceptance of Cherokee Trail Road for maintenance and authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to seek recovery costs involved.

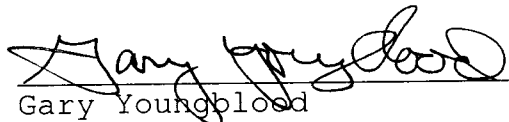
There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, October 6, 2010.
