This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment to Burk-Kleinpeter for engineering services on the following projects:

Patriot Parkway Extension Project \$396.00  
Old Jasper Road Bridge Replacement Project \$1,000.00

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the month of August, 2010.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to assist with the cleanup of the burned building debris from the old Echola Community Center Building.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to assist the City of Northport with clearing the right-of-way on Mitt Lary Road at the intersection of Frank Lary Road to improve sight distance.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept Cherokee Estates Section II Subdivision for County maintenance. This is to correct the motion made in the meeting of September 15, 2010, whereby the County Commission authorized acceptance of Cherokee Trail Road.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, October 20, 2010.




