DEBRIS REMOVAL FROM PRIVATE PROPERTY

WHEREAS, on April 15, 2011, and again on April 27, 2011, the residents of Tuscaloosa County suffered catastrophic damage from a series of tornadoes which struck Alabama; and

WHEREAS, the tornadoes which struck Tuscaloosa County on April 27, 2011, caused severe damage to both public and private property and infrastructure, and resulted in a significant loss of life; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Alabama and the President of the United States have both issued emergency declarations for Tuscaloosa County; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) has adopted policies relating to the removal of debris from private property upon request from local governments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION, that it is in the public interest and serves a public purpose to have debris removed from private property in order to protect and preserve property or public health and safety, and to ensure the economic recovery of the community. Further, the Commission determines that a solitary standing wall constitutes debris and poses a risk to health and safety. Due to the severity and extent of the damage, Tuscaloosa County is unable to perform, or contract to perform, this work in a timely manner. The Chairman of the County Commission is hereby authorized to execute all requests, documents, agreements, or contracts necessary to facilitate the Alabama Emergency Management Agency (EMA) and the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) in implementing debris removal from private property.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, the Tuscaloosa County Commission has caused this Resolution to be executed in its name and on its behalf by its Chairman on this the 18th day of May, 2011.


