This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented a twenty-five year service pin to Donna Snow, Payroll Clerk, and thanked her for her dedicated service to Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of \$27,661.10 to Coaling Water Authority for water line relocation on the Webb Black Road Construction Project.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for steel piling to Skyline Steel LLC based on their January delivery date. The low bidder could not deliver the piling until the end of April.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of an amendment to the contract with Almon Associates

Inc. for the new Southeast (Duncanville) Middle School Access Road Project, Phase I. The amendment, an increase of \$473,800.00, includes final design and construction phase services.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve Change Order No. 1 on the Eastern (LakeView) Elementary School Access Road Project. The Commission approved Option B on the attached exhibit, which represents additional tonnage of riprap for an additional price of \$92,477.78 to the original construction contract with Tomlin Construction, LLC. The additional riprap is needed to backfill under the roadbed where there is an underground spring.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, February 20, 2008.






