This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the following payments to Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc.:

\$19,804.47 for work on the Eastern (LakeView) Elementary Access Road Project

\$31,793.00 for work on Patriot Parkway Extension

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for a lowboy trailer to Thompson Tractor Company. The bids were opened February 6, 2008.

(A) Payment Schedule

Total bid price submitted \$201,736.50, which included a bid bond. Removed the bid bond per TCSO, the new price is \$195,864.00

- (1) \$125,000.00 paid to TCI for equipment delivered to TCI
- (2) \$35,432.00 to be paid after 4th site is installed
- (3) \$35,432.00 final payment after remaining sites are installed, operational & acceptance by TCSO

Note: Equipment should be shipped within 4 – 8 weeks after order is placed. Installation should be complete within 8 weeks after equipment is received. Installation will start when all sites are in place.

(B) Maintenance

- (1) The bid did not include maintenance, maintenance is offered as an option. Year one, after system is operational, the 1st 90 days cover parts & labor. The remaining 9 months will be at a cost of \$13,500.00 as a labor only option. Start date to be determined.

First year maintenance to be added per section B, paragraph (1)

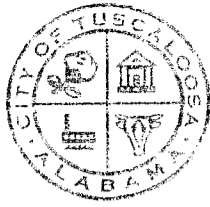

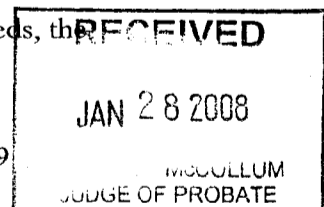
I hope this letter finds you well. As we have discussed, the construction work has been completed for the new Tuscaloosa County Emergency Management Agency (EMA) at the Curry Multi-Use Facility. We are now entering a critical juncture of installing the necessary communication equipment, towers, networks and computer support systems.

At long last, EMA now has a modern and technological advance facility that can be a true resource for our respective public safety departments, staff members, volunteers and media. Furthermore, it is now located in a more autonomous location which will strengthen its role as a multi-jurisdictional agency.

To date, the City has expended nearly \$400,000 on this project and the City of Northport has expended \$50,000 (Northport has pledged an additional \$50,000 over the next two fiscal years). For the completion of EMA's move from its current cramped and outdated location at Tuscaloosa City Hall, the cities of Tuscaloosa and Northport require the financial assistance of the Tuscaloosa County Commission. The request is directed towards the necessary equipment to ensure a backup emergency power and uninterrupted communications at EMA.

The Curry Facility's electrical service was originally designed for a manufacturing plant which has impacted the total cost of installing backup emergency power. To access the actual needs, the

City hired an electrical engineer to review the facility electrical plans. Based on this review, the professional engineer provided recommendations and an estimated cost for providing required emergency backup power for the areas identified as critical to EMA's operation.


Based on the electrical engineer review, the EMA will need a 250 KW generator which is only a fraction of the total cost. An uninterrupted power supply (UPS) is needed to filter the voltage supplied by the generator and to ensure that we do not lose communications during the thirty seconds that it takes for the generator to start providing electrical service. Without the UPS, the computers, radios and other technology equipment connected to Alabama Power would have to reset. Another critical item is the transfer switching system that upon detecting the loss of Alabama Power, will crank the generator and switch key circuits to generator power. The final critical cost is the labor, wiring and various electrical components necessary to interface the generator, UPS and transfer system to provide the automated transfer from Alabama Power to generator power.

The consultant estimated the cost of providing backup power to the EMA portion of the facility at \$240,000.00. In December, this information was forwarded to you by email. By copy of this letter, I am requesting that the Tuscaloosa County Commission fund 50 percent of this project which would be an estimated cost of \$120,000.00. Within the next few weeks, I would recommend that the Tuscaloosa County Commission fund this directly to the City of Tuscaloosa since we are overseeing the construction of this project. Your quick assistance is also necessary due to the long lead time in acquiring a generator of this size and the lead time for installation.

We estimate that upon completion of this project the City of Tuscaloosa's investment will exceed over \$600,000 while the City of Northport will be \$100,000; therefore, I believe this request is extremely reasonable for this County-wide agency.

I hope to hear from you soon so the EMA can be in its new facility in the very near future.
