Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a proposed project to improve the intersection of Martin Road and Union Chapel Road for an estimated cost of \$464,136.10, inclusive of engineering services. The Commission authorized hiring Sentell Engineering Inc. for the design and engineering of said project; and authorized County Attorney Robert Spence to work toward acquiring any rights-of-way necessary to complete the project.






There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, April 16, 2008.





Ladies and Gentlemen:

I have acted as Counsel to Automotive Corridor Industrial Development Authority of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, a public corporation under the laws of the State of Alabama (the "Authority"), in connection with the issuance by the Authority of \$14,645,000 aggregate principal amount of its Special Obligation Bonds, Series 2002 (the "Bonds" or "Series 2002 Bonds") having a maturity date of October 1, 2012 and issued pursuant to a Trust Indenture (the "Indenture") dated as of October 1, 2002 among the Authority and SouthTrust Bank ("Trustee"). Unless otherwise defined herein, terms defined in the Indenture are used herein as therein defined.

The Bonds are limited obligations of the Authority payable solely out of (i) payments by Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, and the Cities of Tuscaloosa and Northport, Alabama (collectively, the "Public Entities") into the Debt Service Fund. Pursuant to three (3) separate agreements (the "Funding Agreements"), each Public Entity has agreed to pay to (or for the account of) the Authority an aggregate sum equal to the amount hereinafter described annually (the "Annual Funding Requirement") in addition to applicable interest and other Periodic Charges that may be due from time to time as such is defined in the Funding Agreements on or before October 1 of each year and continuing to and including October 1, 2012; provided, however, once each Public Entity's total principal payment requirement has been satisfied (the "Principal Payment Obligation"), such Public Entity's obligation to make any further payment under the Funding Agreement shall terminate. The obligations of such Public Entities are

separate and independent and no Public Entity shall be responsible for any payment to be made by any of the other Public Entities. The City of Tuscaloosa's obligation has already terminated by its payment in full of its principal payment obligation under its Funding Agreement.

Tuscaloosa County, Alabama has delivered notice pursuant to their Funding Agreement that they intend to prepay their entire remaining Principal Payment Obligation. The Authority, therefore, desires to facilitate an optional redemption on April 3, 2008 of such amount of Bonds to effectuate such Prepayment.


