Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented a twenty-five year service pin to Beverly Meggs, Chief Clerk in the Tax Collector's Office, and thanked her for her service to Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of \$34,140.00 to Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. for construction management on the LakeView Elementary School Access Road Project.



Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to provide a maximum of \$60,000.00 to Buhl, Elrod and Holman Water Authority to assist the Authority with funding a water line extension and upgrade along Paul Mills Road. The estimated cost of the project, which would upgrade service for thirteen existing customers and provide service to four existing families, is \$146,000.00. If the project costs less than the estimate, the county's contribution would go down proportionately.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, October 15, 2008.



AGREEMENT BETWEEN
TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, ALABAMA
AND THE CITY OF NORTHPORT
FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the City of Northport, Alabama, hereinafter referred to as "City", and Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, hereinafter referred to as "County", are desirous of entering into this Agreement for the maintenance of roads; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to secure services for the maintenance of roads located in the City; and

WHEREAS, the County is willing to enter into an agreement with the City for the maintenance of roads; and

WHEREAS, Schedule "A" attached herein and made a part hereof, describes the equipment necessary to carry out the work of road maintenance and the current hourly rate charged for such equipment, and Schedule "B" attached herein and made a part of hereof, shows the current hourly rate charged for labor.

NOW THEREFORE, the parties hereto mutually agree as follows:

(1) The County will maintain identified roadways within the City upon request, and when equipment and personnel can reasonably be scheduled. Labor, equipment and material and other costs incurred by the County pursuant to such request will be reimbursed by City. Schedule "A" shall be used to determine all equipment costs, Schedule "B" shall be used to determine all labor costs, and County purchase orders shall be used to determine material costs. The total costs to the County for labor, equipment and materials shall determine the reimbursement costs. The County is continuously authorized to modify or amend the rates reflected on Schedule "A" and "B" following 30 day written notice of such change to the City. Nothing stated herein is intended to obligate Tuscaloosa County to perform the above services.

(2) City acknowledges and agrees that the consideration paid to the County hereunder does not include any profit or advantage to the County and reflects only the actual cost to the County for the service requested by the City. It is the intention of the City and the County that the County shall not incur any liability for damages to City, its employees or third parties by reason of this Agreement or any services provided hereunder. Accordingly, City hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless and defend the County, its elected officials, officers and employees from any claims, suits, judgments, liability, damages, costs or expenses in any way arising out of the Agreement or the services provided under this Agreement. City shall remain liable for the indemnity, hold harmless and defense obligation and all other obligations of this Agreement as to any such claim, suit or judgment, whenever such claim of suit is made. The County agrees to use its best efforts to respond to requests for maintenance service hereunder. However, City acknowledges and agrees that the county has no responsibility or liability to respond to requests for maintenance service within any specified period of time.

(3) This Agreement supersedes any other contract or implied contract between the parties for road maintenance services.

(4) This Agreement may be terminated by either party giving written notice to the other party. City shall remain liable for payment for any services or supplies furnished hereunder incurred before actual receipt by the County of such written notice. Notice shall be made on any one of the following:

TO COUNTY: Commission Chairman with a copy to County Engineer

WAIVER OF SUBDIVISION REGULATIONS


This limited waiver of subdivision regulations is hereby entered into by and between the Tuscaloosa County Commission, on behalf of and with authority of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, a political subdivision of the State of Alabama, and is applicable for the limited persons, purposes, and properties hereinafter described.

With knowledge of an encroachment upon the drainage easement granted to Tuscaloosa County and its various departments, the Tuscaloosa County Commission does hereby expressly waive any right to enforce the subdivision regulations and rights related thereto in connection with the Waterford Place subdivision, as platted in Plat Book _____ at Page(s) _____ as recorded in the Probate Court of Tuscaloosa County. Such waiver is limited to such regulations concerning said drainage easement, and the above-described encroachment onto Lot 3, as platted.

Tuscaloosa County, the Tuscaloosa County Commission and its various departments, expressly reserves all rights of enforcement under the subdivision regulations, subdivision plat, and any other documents or agreements pertaining to the above-named subdivision and lots therein, specifically including drainage regulations and rights of enforcement on all other lots not specifically waived herein. As noted on the plat, however, Tuscaloosa County is not responsible for the maintenance of any drainage structures described on the plat.

This waiver is enforceable only by the owners of Lot 3, Waterford Place, their agents, successors and assigns. This waiver is intended to run with the land in perpetuity or until deemed unenforceable or inapplicable by the parties hereto, their successors and assigns, or a Court of proper jurisdiction.

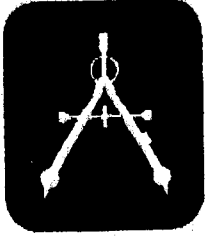

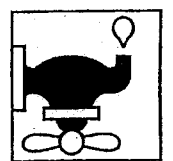
