





when improving Wesley Chapel Road. Mr. Cunningham does not want the fence erected in the original location, and Tuscaloosa County cannot work off county right-of-way. Tuscaloosa County proposes to purchase 1280 feet of fence for Mr. Cunningham that he can erect or pay him the cost of 1280 feet of fence.


Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer to work in conjunction with the City of Tuscaloosa to repair the erosion damage (washout) in a ditch near Crabtree Downs and Laurel Wood Subdivision. If the City of Tuscaloosa refuses to cooperate, Tuscaloosa County will proceed to repair the damage.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to waive the fifty foot right-of-way requirement on Poplar Springs Road. This action facilitates making improvements to said road.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 15, 2004.
