

SUMMER YOUTH PROGRAM

The Tuscaloosa County Commission and PARA have joined forces to provide summer jobs for Tuscaloosa City and Tuscaloosa County high school students. To be eligible you must be age 16-21, currently enrolled in high school, a 2019 high school graduate, or 2nd year college student. Each selected applicant will be competing against two other applicants during the interview process. Be prepared to present yourself professionally and when hired do a great job. Several of last year's students were invited back to the same job as last summer.

The County Commission along with the support of its Department Heads will be providing ten jobs. Those interested in working for Tuscaloosa County must fill out an application at the Personnel Office at the Tuscaloosa County Courthouse between 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

The County Commission has provided additional funding for approximately thirty jobs through the Park and Recreation Authority (PARA). Those interested in being employed by PARA can apply online at www.tcpara.org or in person at the Belk Activity Center or the Bobby Miller Activity Center.

The application process will close at 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 24, 2019 or when the numbers reach 3 times the number of available jobs.
