This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of December 2, 2020.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of December 16, 2020.

Chairman Rob Robertson presented Tuscaloosa County Sheriff's Office Communications Supervisor Shannon Pate a twenty-five year service pin and thanked her for her dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Chairman Rob Robertson presented Tuscaloosa County License Commission Files Manager Deborah Jo Booth a twenty-five year service pin and thanked her for her dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session prior to the end of this meeting to discuss a contract and board appointments.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson requested to table the agenda item to approve the preliminary subdivision plat submission for 69 South Division in District III.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Lavender Highway 69 South Subdivision in District III.

Commissioner Reginald Murray requested to table the agenda items to assess costs of demolition of a structure at 39 Sahama Village and to remove 6346 62nd Ave from the public nuisance/demo list as presented by County Attorney Robert Spence.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$10,000.00 from the District II discretionary fund to the Town of Vance for work on a ballpark.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$10,000.00 from the District II discretionary fund to the Town of Coaling for fence work on a ballpark field.

The Commission retired into Executive Session.

Following Executive Session, Chairman Rob Robertson called the Commission back to order.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve payment of \$27,671.25 to McGiffert and Associates related to the Holt Sewer Project to resolve a contract negotiation.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Mr. Mark Crews, Mr. Gary Minor, Ms. Debbie Hughes, Mr. Tim Parker III, and Mr. Norman Crow to the Industrial Development Authority Board for a new 4-year term.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Gary Nichols to the Industrial Development Authority Board for a 4-year term.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Lance Wyatt to the Tuscaloosa County Library Board. His term will expire November 1, 2024.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, January 20, 2021.
