This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of February 3, 2021.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the purchase of a lot, Parcel # 633109291001023003, in escheatment with the State of Alabama for the amount of \$100.00 and to develop a plan for sale of the lot to the public.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Harless Place, in District I.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Reynolds Subdivision, in District I.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss tree removal for PARA at Ol' Colony Golf Course.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to assist PARA in tree removal for an irrigation project at Ol' Colony Golf Course.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for January 2021.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize settlement in the case of Allison Childs v. Tuscaloosa County in the amount of \$6,500.00.

Upon request by Maintenance Superintendent Ryan Sabbagh, Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize purchase of two (2) 180 ton water-cooled chillers for the Tuscaloosa County Courthouse and Sheriff's Office in the amount of \$387,795.00.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$15,000.00, to be divided equally between the District II discretionary fund, District III discretionary fund, and District IV discretionary fund (\$5,000.00 each), to the Community Services Meals on Wheels program.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve and support a Bill to be presented in the current Legislative Session proposing a 4% lodging tax for Tuscaloosa County, the covenants of which would distribute 50% of the proceeds to fund the District Attorney's Office and related public safety, 15% to support park and recreation activities, 5% to support and increase tourism efforts, 15% to support library operations, and 15% to support the County Road and Bridge Department for road construction and maintenance.
