This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of March 3, 2021.

The County Commission set a process to determine minimum bid price and process for sale of County property redeemed in escheatment.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare County-owned parcel #633109291001023003 as surplus property and post it for bid.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve setting the minimum bid price for the above-referenced surplus property to be set at \$4,763.00, which is one-half the lien for cost of demolition.

Chairman Rob Robertson presented Tuscaloosa County Equipment Operator I James O'Hanlon a twenty-five year service pin and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Chairman Rob Robertson presented Tuscaloosa County Equipment Operator III Phillip Morris a twenty-five year service pin and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.
