This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of March 24, 2021.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to amend the agenda to add an item regarding a grant application by EMA.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize EMA Director Nick Lolley to submit a grant application for a storm shelter in Duncanville.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session prior to the end of this meeting to discuss a personnel matter.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to participate in and begin the RFP process for the administration of the Emergency Rental Assistance Program.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a subdivision regulation waiver request for Jamie and Lauren Oswalt Subdivision, District I.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare seven (7) triaxle dumps trucks in the Engineering Department as surplus and authorize their trade-in.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session prior to the end of this meeting to discuss potential litigation and contract negotiations.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an auditing contract as presented by Tax Assessor Leigh Ann Fair.

Commissioner Stan Acker's motion to provide funding in the amount of \$40,000.00 each to Tuscaloosa County High School and Northside High School for their athletic facilities was seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray. After discussion, Commissioner Reginald Murray requested to amend the motion to fund \$40,000.00 to Northside High School from the District I discretionary fund,

\$40,000.00 to Tuscaloosa County High School divided equally between the District I and District IV discretionary funds (\$20,000.00 each), and \$40,000.00 to Sipsy Valley High School divided equally between the District I and District IV discretionary funds (\$20,000.00 each). Commissioner Stan Acker accepted the amended motion, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the expenditures.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize chairs and equipment to be provided for the Holt Storm Shelter; funding to be provided from the remainder of the grant and the difference, if any, from the General Fund.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Reverend Roy Ferguson to the Coker Water Authority. His term will expire March 1, 2027.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve District IV discretionary funding in the amount of \$6,000.00 to PARA for the youth baseball program.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize demolition of a structure at 6319 Pearson Cir.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to accept Benton Bend Road and Lackey Lane Phase I into the County road maintenance program was seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle. The motion failed 2-2, with Commissioner Stan Acker and Commissioner Mark C. Nelson casting NAY votes.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to address placing a stop sign in the Holt Community.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to place a STOP sign at the intersection of 21<sup>st</sup> St. NE and 39<sup>th</sup> Ave. NE, Holt.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, April 21, 2021.
