This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of April 21, 2021.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session at the conclusion of the regular meeting to discuss contract negotiations.

Chairman Rob Robertson presented Tuscaloosa County Detention Deputy Supervisor Sherry Jones a twenty-five year service pin and thanked her for her dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for the Campbell Family Subdivision, District I.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Plantation Ridge, District III.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to table the agenda item regarding the Emergency Rental Assistance Program administrative services proposals.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session at the conclusion of the regular meeting to discuss an additional contract negotiation.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to vacate a portion of Old Jasper Road.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to begin condemnation proceedings on the structure at 15765 Old Greensboro Road, District III.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Sheriff's Office to proceed with the refurbishing of approximately 52 old AEDs. Total cost is approximately \$11,600.00 from the General Fund at this time, and it is possibly a reimbursable item under the American Rescue Plan Act 2021. The distribution of the refurbished AEDs will be determined at a later date.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare an additional 2010 Chevrolet Suburban to the Sheriff's Office surplus list presented on April 21, 2021.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to reject the bids received for the Laundry Equipment at the Jail and to authorize Maintenance Superintendent Ryan Sabbagh to rebid the project with the modified specifications to allow for fire suppression and lint removal system.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to approve funding in the amount of \$25,000.00 from each district's discretionary fund, for a total of \$100,000.00, to PARA for the Summer Youth Job Program failed for lack of a second.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$25,000.00 from the District IV discretionary fund to PARA for the Summer Youth Job Program.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$10,000.00 from the District II discretionary fund to PARA for the Summer Youth Job Program.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Engineering to haul material donated from the Todd Shirley Pit to Northside High School for road build out by the baseball field. Expected 6-8 loads, not to exceed 12, hauling costs to be paid from the District I discretionary fund.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Avery Pruitt to fill the unexpired term on the Coker Water Board created by the passing of Reverend Roy Ferguson. The term will expire March 1, 2027.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, May 19, 2021.
