This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of May 5, 2021.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the high bid in the amount of \$7,100.00 by John E. Rainey for a parcel of land at 4906 21st Street.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for the McPherson Property, District I.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare nine (9) used motor graders as surplus in preparation for the purchase of new motor graders.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to award the Emergency Rental Assistance Program administrative services contract to Community Services of West Alabama was seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle. The motion failed on a 2-2 vote with Commissioner Stan Acker and Commissioner Mark C. Nelson casting the NAY votes.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for April 2021.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the U.S. Corps of Engineers contract, whereby the Tuscaloosa County Sheriff's Office will provide law enforcement services for Corps of Engineers operated and maintained areas on Oliver and Holt Lakes in Tuscaloosa County during the summer months.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously approve the sale of a Sheriff's Office surplus vehicle, 2010 Chevrolet K1500 Suburban, to the Duncanville Volunteer Fire Department for the amount of \$1,000.00.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to approve the sale of a Sheriff's Office surplus vehicle, 2007 Ford Expedition, to the Fosters Ralph Volunteer Fire Department for an amount to be determined later failed for lack of a second.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the sale of a Sheriff's Office surplus vehicle, 2007 Ford Expedition, to the Fosters Ralph Volunteer Fire Department for a minimum of \$1,000.00.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Sheriff's Office to donate refurbished AEDs as follows:

- Brookwood Police Department - 8
- Vance Police Department - 5
- Coaling Police Department - 4
- Lake View Police Department - 4
- Tuscaloosa County Board of Education - 27

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the contract for professional services on the 35th Street Sheriff's Office Construction Project to Marcum Architects and Harrison Construction Management.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Maintenance Superintendent Ryan Sabbagh to purchase 60 new ExpressVote electronic ballot marking machines for disabled voters in the amount of \$150,000.00. Funds to purchase these machines will come from the HAVA Fund.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize usage of the front Courthouse lawn by the SCLC, including the set up of an audio system and 200 chairs, on June 27, 2021.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, June 2, 2021.
