This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of May 19, 2021.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution to exempt certain "covered items" from the county sales and use tax during the third full weekend of July 2021, (July 16-18, 2021), as authorized by Act 2017-120, generally referred to as the State Sales Tax Holiday Legislation.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mayor Walt Maddox to the Tuscaloosa County E911 Board.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a subdivision regulation waiver request for Branch Subdivision, District III, in the City of Tuscaloosa Planning Jurisdiction.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a subdivision regulation waiver request for Pine Ridge, District I.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for nine (9) motor graders to Thompson Tractor.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle's motion to award the Emergency Rental Assistance Program administrative services contract to Horne LLP, Yardi, and Community Services of West Alabama, contingent upon them working together, was seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray. The motion failed on a 2-2 vote with Commissioner Stan Acker and Commissioner Mark C. Nelson casting the NAY votes.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson's motion to authorize Assistant County Administrator David Howell to contact the agencies who submitted an RFP regarding the Emergency Rental Assistance Program to determine their ability and willingness to work with the other agencies through a hybrid model was seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray. Commissioner Reginald Murray offered an amendment to the motion to have a special called meeting on Thursday, June 10, 2021 for discussion. The amendment was accepted by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson. The Commission voted unanimously to approve.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 504 Crescent Ridge Road from the public nuisance/demo list. The property was cleaned by the owner.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously approve the sale of a Sheriff's Office surplus vehicle, 2011 Ford truck with 214,000 miles, to the Samantha Volunteer Fire Department for the amount of \$1,000.00.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the sale of a Sheriff's Office surplus vehicle, 2006 truck with 151,000 miles, to the Tannehill Park Rangers for a minimum of \$1,000.00 to be paid from the District II discretionary fund.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an expenditure in the amount of \$2200.00 from the District II discretionary fund to PARA for two (2) aluminum bleachers for the Abernant Ball Park.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare three (3) old sets of wooden bleachers at Abernant Ball Park as surplus and authorize them for public bid.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to discuss formation of a committee to look at racial employment ratios within Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to form a committee to study the issues regarding racial employment ratios within Tuscaloosa County was seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle. After discussion, Commissioner Reginald Murray amended his motion to appoint himself as one of the members to the committee. The motion, as amended, was seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle. The County Commission voted unanimously to approve.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, June 16, 2021.
