This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of September 15, 2021.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve execution of an agreement with West Alabama Regional Commission for their work on the County Commission redistricting project.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$11,000.00 from the District III discretionary fund to Maxwell Elementary to match funds for a concrete walking track around the Pre-K playground.
