This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of October 6, 2021.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session at the conclusion of the regular meeting to discuss board appointments and contract negotiations.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to table the agenda item regarding redistricting the County Commission districts failed for lack of a second.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson's motion to approve proposal 5 redistricting the County Commission districts was seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker. The motion passed 3-1 with Commissioner Reginald Murray casting the NAY vote.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle's motion to approve funding for a Senior Accountant position in the County's Finance Department was seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker. The motion passed 3-1 with Commissioner Reginald Murray casting the NAY vote.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 15765 Old Greensboro Road from the public nuisance/demo list. The site has been cleaned by owner and inspected by Environmental Coordinator Brent Lollar.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$23,230.00, to be split between the District I discretionary fund and the District IV discretionary fund (\$11,615.00 each), to the Coker Fire Department for extrication equipment.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve funding in the amount of \$5,000.00 from the District I discretionary fund to the Northside High School Athletics golf team for equipment purchase.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Public Works to stripe the roads within the Sipse Valley Middle and High School campus at approximately \$13,000.00 from the District IV discretionary fund.

The Commission retired into executive session and did not reconvene.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, November 3, 2021.
