This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of November 3, 2021 and November 10, 2021.

Chairman Rob Robertson presented Tuscaloosa County Chief Deputy Byron Waid a thirty-five year service pin and thanked him for his dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve an ambulance service contract with Northstar Ambulance Company as recommended by the Sheriff's Office.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize PARA to solicit Request for Proposals for the Sokol Park lighting project to include the ball fields and a separate line item for the north soccer field.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Wedgewood, resurvey of lot 22 and unplatted land, District II.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for A Part of Unit 70, District III.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for October 2021.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for cooling towers to Jolly Heating and Air Conditioning in the amount of \$175,000.00, as recommended by Maintenance Superintendent Ryan Sabbagh.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to modify District I American Rescue Plan Act funds for Carroll's Creek Water from tank repainting to be used instead for meter replacement to purchase 840 meters in the amount of \$155,400.00.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to move District II American Rescue Plan Act funds from the Warrior River Water Board, who voted to not move forward with their water projects, to be reassigned to Peterson Water (McGiffert) for water main replacement projects in the amount of \$350,000.00.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept recommendations made by the Diversity Economic Committee to be considered in the County's HR hiring practices.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to freeze hiring until a hiring process plan is in place failed for lack of a second.
