This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Chairman W. Hardy McCollum read into the record and presented to Mr. Dennis Duncan a proclamation proclaiming February 2016, as "CAREER AND TECHNICAL EDUCATION MONTH."

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution accepting the streets and drainage structures located in the dedicated street rights-of-way of the Magnolia Forest subdivision for maintenance by the Tuscaloosa County Engineering Department.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for December 2015.



The current contract is set to expire January 31, 2016.



Commissioner Jerry Tingle motion's to approve and allow Mercedes International to install directional signs on Will Walker Road and M Class Boulevard as part of a signage project passed with a unanimous vote.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to research the legal issues related to County residents connecting onto city sewer systems.


**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STREETS IN
Magnolia Forest**

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has reported to the Tuscaloosa County Commission that the County Engineering Department has inspected and found that the streets, together with the drainage structures in the streets in **Magnolia Forest** are completed in accordance with the Subdivision Regulations of the Tuscaloosa County Commission, and that all of said construction has been done in accordance with the County specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION:

1. That the County accepts the streets, together with the drainage structures in, and which are a part of, said streets which are located in dedicated street rights-of-way, for maintenance by the Tuscaloosa County Commission. The drainage structures described herein are those structures which are part of or are located in the streets (curb and gutter, catch basins, flumes and pipes) and do not include any natural waterway which drains surface water in the area.
2. This resolution shall be effective on the date of the adoption thereof.
