Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid on the Wire Road FEMA project to Dominion Construction for the amount of \$394,288.00, as recommended by the County Engineer.


WHEREAS, the parties to the litigation have agreed to a settlement of the dispute.






