

The Tuscaloosa County Commission recognized the bicentennial of Tuscaloosa County. Tuscaloosa County was established on February 6, 1818.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Tuesday, February 21, 2018.




