
There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, January 5, 2011.





ORDER ESTABLISHING CEMETERY




Dear Judge:

I conducted an evaluation of the proposed North River Memorial Gardens Cemetery site and reviewed the submitted information. I found there were signs of a water table at 48" in one area. This area has been proposed to be reserved for mausoleums only. The rest of the property had no water table indicators within 72 inches of the soil surface. I do not believe the proposed cemetery will pose a threat to the environment, people, or water supplies. The application has been approved.
