This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session at the conclusion of the meeting to discuss a personnel matter.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum, on behalf of the Association of County Commissions, presented a resolution to Representative John Merrill recognizing him for his service to all county governments in Alabama and specifically for his efforts to pass Legislative Act No. 2011-685 during its 2011 regular session to grant correction officers and reserve deputies the same immunities and legal protection granted to the Sheriff under the general laws and of the constitution of 1901 so long as he or she is acting within the line and scope of his or her duties and acting in compliance with the law.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize

Whereas, the Recipient is organized to provide and is desirous of providing services beneficial to the general welfare of all citizens of the County.


In consideration of the compensation and covenants contained herein, the Commission and the Recipient mutually agree as follows:




