This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of invoices to Burk-Kleinpeter for engineering services on the following:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of \$2,142.00 to The Cassady Company, Inc. for engineering and inspection services in conjunction with the water main relocation on the Springer Road Construction Project.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the following bids:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for base processing on Sand Road to S. T. Bunn Construction Company. The single bid received was for \$28,675.60, and an attempt to negotiate that bid was not successful.

Following discussion, the Commission voted unanimously to accept Thompson Tractor Company as the low bidder for four backhoe loaders with a bid price of \$411,840.00 and Deanco Auction Company as the high bidder with a bid price of \$172,400.00 for the purchase of four 2007 Caterpillar 420E backhoe loaders. These bids were referred to the Engineering Department for appropriate action at the meeting of May 2, 2012.

Estimated cost is \$33,900.00.





There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, June 6, 2012.






Dear Mr. Butler,
