Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Sherie Giles to the Tuscaloosa County Library Board. The term will expire November 1, 2017.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, October 2, 2013.

5-4-24 Minimum Setback Lines

The minimum interior building setbacks lines shall be defined as the following:

- 30 feet along and adjacent to the front property line of the lot (abutting the street).
- 35 feet along and adjacent to the rear property line.
- 10 feet along and adjacent to both sides of the property line on each side (20 feet total).

Easements may be located within the minimum building setback lines.
