This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for transmission service and oil changes with

filter and related products to Speedy Oil Change, the lowest bidder meeting specifications and requirements. The bids were opened September 11, 2013.

Commissioner Stan Acker moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize an amendment to a funding allocation previously approved, of \$12,805.00, to the Echola Volunteer Fire Department for site preparation of a safe room. Due to the lowest bidder for this project including some "in kind donation", the actual cost of the site preparation will only be \$8,100.00. The amendment is to allow Echola Volunteer Fire Department to use the excess funds for building costs other than just site preparation.




There being no further business to come before the
