




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 6, 2014.

Dear Commissioners,

The Town of Coaling has been having numerous complaints about the Middle Coaling Road area for several years. The specific area on Middle Coaling Road that has been the topic of many complaints is at the intersection of Middle Coaling Road and Jack Lunceford Drive.

This intersection is at the top of a hill crest and has proven to be difficult to enter and exit out of most any time of day. Also the residents that live on Magnolia Drive, down the north side of the hill will benefit from a safer entry and exit to that neighborhood as well. For safety reasons the Town of Coaling, Coaling Police, and the citizens that live in this affected area, request that the intersection be turned into a Three -Way Stop.

The area affected by this will be Jack Lunceford Drive, and Magnolia Drive directly. The Three-Way Stop intersection will make the entry and exit of these two areas safer for our town. The Mayor of Coaling, William O. Burkhalter has already been in contact with Commissioner Jerry Tingle, District 2, and he understands the concerns about the area. The Coaling Town Council has also voiced concern about the area and asked the mayor and myself to proceed as needed to get the intersection made safe.


