Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution providing Tuscaloosa County's participation in the "Severe Weather Preparedness Sales Tax Holiday" as authorized by Act No. 2012-256, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on Friday, February 20, 2015 and ending at 12:00 midnight on Sunday, February 22, 2015, the last full weekend of February in 2015.





RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR TUSCALOOSA COUNTY'S PARTICIPATION IN THE "SEVERE WEATHER PREPAREDNESS SALES TAX HOLIDAY" AS AUTHORIZED BY ACT NO. 2012-256 IN JULY 2012

WHEREAS, during its 2012 Regular Session, the Alabama Legislature enacted Act No. 2012-256, effective April 26, 2012, which provides an exemption of the state sales and use tax for certain severe weather preparedness supplies during the last full weekend in July 2012 and the last full weekend of February of each subsequent year; and

WHEREAS, Act No. 2012-256 authorizes the county commission to provide for an exemption of county sales and use taxes for purchases of items covered by the Act during the same time period in which the state sales and use tax exemption is in place, provided a resolution to that effect is adopted at least fourteen days prior to 12:01 a.m. on the first Friday in July 2012, and at least 30 days prior to the last full weekend of February in subsequent years;

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission has affirmatively voted to grant the exemption of county sales and use taxes on purchases covered by Act No. 2012-256 during the last full weekend of February 2015, beginning at 12:01 a.m. on February 20, 2015 and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday, February 22, 2015; and

WHEREAS, Code of Alabama 1975, § 11-51-210(e) requires that the County Commission notify the Alabama Department of Revenue of any new local tax or amendment to an existing local tax levy at least 30 days prior to the effective date of the change; and

WHEREAS, the exemption of certain county sales and use taxes for the last full weekend of February 2015 herein adopted by the county commission is an amendment to the county's sales and use tax levy warranting notice to the Alabama Department of Revenue as provided in Code of Alabama 1975, § 11-51-210(e);

WHEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION that it does hereby provide for an exemption of the county sales and use tax on purchases of items covered by Act No. 2012-256 beginning at 12:01 a.m. on February 20, 2015 and ending at twelve midnight on Sunday, February 22, 2015.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution be spread upon the minutes of the December 3, 2014 meeting of the Tuscaloosa County Commission, and be immediately forwarded to the Alabama Department of Revenue in compliance with Code of Alabama 1975, § 11-51-210(e).

With on-going support from the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs (ADECA), you and your staff, the Tuscaloosa County Commission, in conjunction with the residents and community recovery improvement groups in the Holt Community, is proceeding forward with the implementation of this major sanitary sewer project which will benefit approximately 291 existing households and many future residents through the provision of access to sanitary sewer.

With this goal in mind and due to the fact that the construction bids came in in excess of the estimated cost for the sanitary sewer extension phase of the project, it is the request of the Tuscaloosa County Commission that the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs approve Formal Amendment, Number 3 to the referenced project which will allow the deletion of the Demolition and Clearance phase of the project and the allocation of the \$215,000.00 in grant funds and \$35,000.00 in County funds to the Sanitary Sewer phase of the project. If approved, an additional amount totaling \$269,882.17 in local funds will still be required to complete the construction as bid.


Regarding the overall project, the County will focus on the demolition and clearance activities in the Holt Community with the primary focus being concentrated on the efforts to develop the "New Foundry Project." A photograph is included showing the initial demolition and clearance which will be undertaken with local funds upon receipt of approval of the subject Formal Amendment request, if deemed appropriate, by ADECA.

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission supports efforts to improve and enhance the quality of life for residents of the County and has been approved for \$7,338,230.00 in grant funds for the implementation of the Tuscaloosa County Holt Community Sanitary Sewer Project from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, Supplemental Disaster Recovery Fund, Project Number: DTR-13-02, as administered by the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs; and


WHEREAS, the submission and approval of a Formal Amendment is required for proposed changes to the original project which would involve the deletion of the project activity, Demolition and Clearance, the transfer of the grant funds of \$215,000.00 and matching funds of \$35,000.00 allocated to this activity to the Sanitary Sewer Construction phase of the project and amending the program budget to reflect the revised total figures for the cost of the project for the Holt Community; and


WHEREAS, a Public Hearing has been held to inform the public and receive input regarding the proposed amendment and no negative comments were or have been received by the County; and
