This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to cancel the Commission Meeting scheduled for August 19, 2015.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment of an invoice to Burk-Kleinpeter for engineering services on the Holman Church Road bridge replacement project in the amount of \$11,300.00.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 2, 2015.







TO BE 1 HOUR FIRE RATED


THIS AREA TYPICAL TO


