This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Mr. Clarence Gary to the Indian Rivers Mental Health Board. His term will expire April 1, 2020.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Stan Acker, the County Commission voted unanimously to remove 19402 Abernant Loop Road N, Vance, from the public nuisance demolition list. The structure was privately demolished.

The County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for June 2018.






There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 8, 2018.
