This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned; the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge Rob Robertson presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the minutes of August 19, 2020.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving and accepting the preliminary plat submission for Dogwood Trace, resurvey of lot 10, in District II.

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept streets in Quail Ridge Phase 3, in District III, into the County Road Maintenance system.

Commissioner Jerry Tingle moved, seconded by Commissioner Mark C. Nelson, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the recommendation by the County Engineer that the Commission enter into agreements with ALDOT for funding of repairs to FHWA routes in Tuscaloosa County that were damaged in the February flood event. The agreement funds the repairs at 80 percent Federal Emergency Relief Funds and 20 percent by county funds. The projects are:

Covered Bridge Road - Cross Drain Repair
Highway 140 - Junction Box Repair
Highway 140 - Slide Repair
Highway 140 - Erosion Repair
Upper Columbus Road - Scour Repair 1
Upper Columbus Road - Scour Repair 2
Upper Columbus Road - Slide Repair
Old Greensboro Road - Slide Repair 1
Old Greensboro Road - Slide Repair 2

Commissioner Mark C. Nelson moved, seconded by Commissioner Jerry Tingle, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the 2021 Rebuild Alabama County Transportation Plan as presented by County Engineer Scott Anders.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, September 16, 2020.

RESOLUTION ACCEPTING PRELIMINARY PLAT


**Dogwood Trace




**RESOLUTION ACCEPTING STREETS IN
Quail Ridge
Phase 3**

WHEREAS, the County Engineer has reported to the Tuscaloosa County Commission that the County Engineering Department has inspected and found that the streets, together with the drainage structures in the streets in Quail Ridge, Phase 3, are completed in accordance with the Subdivision Regulations of the Tuscaloosa County Commission, and that all of said construction has been done in accordance with the County specifications.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION:

1. That the County accepts the streets, together with the drainage structures in, and which are a part of, said streets which are located in dedicated street rights-of-way, for maintenance by the Tuscaloosa County Commission. The drainage structures described herein are those structures which are part of or are located in the streets (curb and gutter, catch basins, flumes and pipes) and do not include any natural waterway which drains surface water in the area.
2. This resolution shall be effective on the date of the adoption thereof.

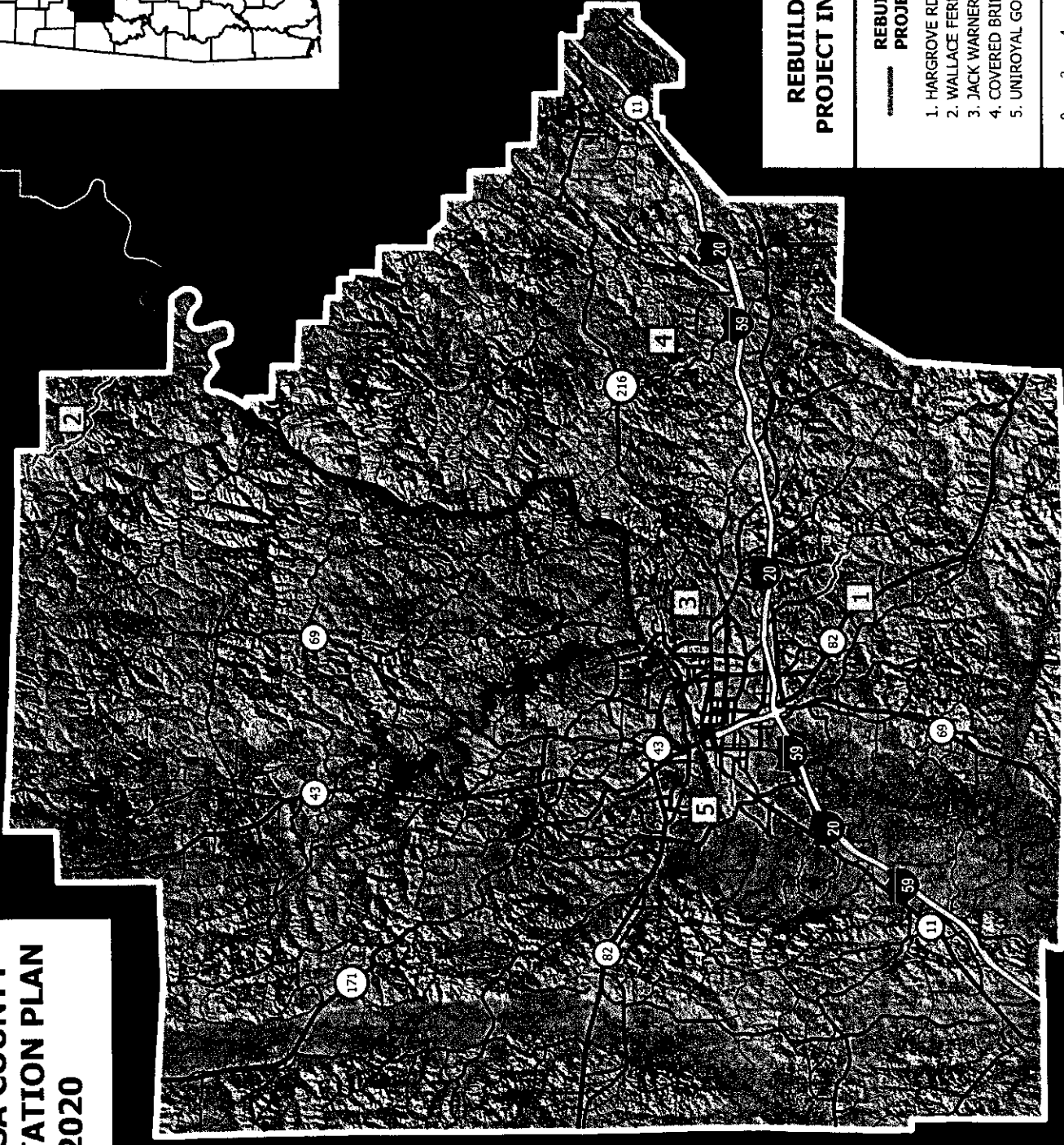
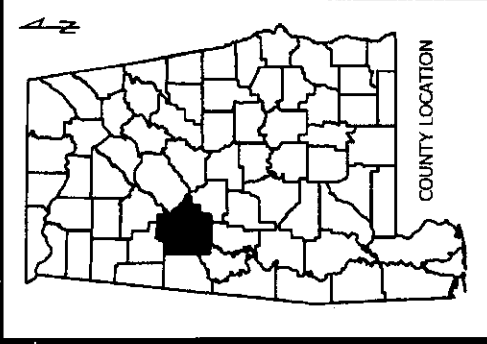

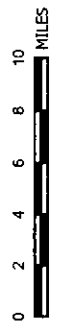
