This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Bobby Miller
Reginald Murray

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a material option with Brown Wood Preserving. This material is for backfill at the Brownville Pike bridge at a cost of forty cents per cubic yard.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a Special Work Authorization (SWA) Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with the Alabama Department of Transportation. Under this agreement, the Alabama Department of Transportation will provide maintenance of existing and future traffic control signals on State routes in Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Almon Associates \$9,625 for professional services performed on the US 82 to Duncanville Middle School road project during December, 2006.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. \$520, invoice No. 11, for professional services on the County Road 2 Connector Road Project.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to reject all bids received for asphalt plant mix bid on a county-wide basis; and to rebid same, dividing the bid into two sections - one to supply asphalt north of the Black Warrior River and one to supply asphalt south of the river. 


Commissioner Don Wallace's motion to table Commissioner Gary Youngblood's motion to fund one additional Deputy position failed for lack of a second.



All materials furnished and installation of said materials shall comply with the State of Alabama Department Of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2002 Edition (hereinafter referred to as the "Specifications") and to the ALDOT Special and Standard Highway Drawings, 2004. 




