MEETING

February 7, 2007

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Gary Youngblood

Reginald Murray

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid on the installation of guardrails and anchors to Alabama Guardrail. The bids were opened January 17, 2007.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid on resurfacing Lake Nicol Road, Warrior Road, Reichold Road, and the walking track at Walker Elementary School to S.T. Bunn Construction Company, Inc. The bids were opened January 17, 2007.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to extend the metal pipe bid with Contech Construction Products for one (1) year, providing Contech's 45.5 percent discount from the Alabama CSP Price List is not decreased and the price of metal pipe does not drop significantly.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to renew SprayMax Inc.'s contract for herbicide application services on

county roads for one (1) year. The bid, \$146,188.04, was opened February 15, 2006.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications for asphalt plant mix for use on county roads. Bidding firms were as follows:

Ms. Toni Franklin, Director of United Cerebral Palsy in Tuscaloosa County, presented the County Commission with a request for \$25,000 as the county's share of funding for a proposed fully accessible community playground and park with facilities for children with and without disabilities.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum read into the record and presented to Holt High School Principal Cliff Booth a proclamation proclaiming the week of February 11-17, 2007, as "CAREER/TECHNICAL EDUCATION WEEK" in Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to set ad valorem millage rates for the 2006-2007 tax year. The millage rate remains the same as the previous tax year, except for the millage rate for School District I and II, which increased from 4.0 mills to 4.5 mills. This .5 millage rate increase is because of a state-wide act that requires a minimum levy of ten mills in every school district.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish Tuscaloosa County's alcoholic beverage license fees for fiscal 2007-2008. The levies remain the same as last year.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Bobby Hagler, Bill Lamb, and Sammy Swindle to the Black Warrior Solid Waste Authority. These six (6) year terms will expire on April 4, 2013.

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum read into the record and presented to Maxie Thomas, Director of the West Alabama Traffic Safety Program, a proclamation proclaiming the week of February 11th through February 17th, 2007, to be "CHILD PASSENGER SAFETY WEEK" in Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the following months of 2006:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving an Amendment to Certificate of Incorporation of the Coker Water Authority. The resolution permits an increase in compensation for each director of said authority. The maximum compensation allowed is \$200 per meeting, with an annual maximum of \$2,400 for the Board of Directors; and \$300 per meeting, with an annual maximum of \$3,600 for the Chairman of the Board of Directors.

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, and upon motion by Commissioner Don Wallace, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the settlement of the case Racon, Inc. versus Tuscaloosa County, Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc., and Tuscaloosa Testing Laboratories, Inc., Civil Action CV-2002-0064 for \$675,000. The settlement proceeds are being provided by the State of Alabama Department of Transportation, and the settlement compensates RaCon for the retainage held on the Mitt Lary Road Extension project (now Rose Boulevard), as well as claims for idle equipment during the construction of the road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Road Department to provide routine road maintenance on Sunrise Drive.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to request the Alabama Department of Transportation to approve the proposed Carrolls Creek Parkway project as a state project. The county further committed \$6 million toward this project and will request the state to provide the balance (\$17 million) of the estimated \$23 million to complete this 6 mile, 3 lane road project. This road, to connect Alabama Highway 43N to Watermelon Road, is being proposed to alleviate traffic congestion on Mitt Lary Road, Martin Road, and McFarland Boulevard.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a request from Brookwood High School. Tuscaloosa County will construct a pad for two batting cages at the school at an estimated cost of \$1,900 for the project.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a request from Vance Elementary School. Tuscaloosa County will construct a new road north of the school playground and remove the old road between the playground and school. Estimated cost of this project is \$18,351.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to provide \$60,000 from District Development Funds toward construction of an "Activity Building" at Westwood Elementary School. The funds will be appropriated from 2007-2008 District Development Funds as follows: \$30,000 from District I and \$30,000 from District IV.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted three to one to install two (2) speed tables on 36th Avenue. Commissioner Gary Youngblood cast the NAY vote.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to participate


on a 50-50 basis in a water extension project on Commerce Drive in cooperation with the Coker Water Authority. The county further authorized an open cut on County Road 2 to facilitate this project. Permitting an open cut of County Road 2 will reduce the cost of the project. The contractor's cost for boring under the road was \$12,000. This project is under the auspices of the county's water extension program.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, February 21, 2007.
