This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented Hazel Newell, Supervisor of Recording in the Probate Office, a twenty-five year service pin from Tuscaloosa County and thanked her for her years of dedicated and efficient service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the following base processing projects to the low bidder meeting specifications. Bidders were as follows:

Upon recommendation by McGiffert and Associates, LLC, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for the Rifle Range Road Water Expansion Project to the low bidder, Price Construction Co., Inc., in the amount of \$37,174.92. Among eight bidders, the price ranged from the low of \$37,174.92 to a high of \$73,850.00. The bids were opened by the Planning Department on May 1, 2007.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution requiring the recognition and evaluation of flood, mudslides, or flood losses pursuant to Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, Sections 11-19-1, et seq. The County Commission is assuring the Federal Insurance Administration that it will enact as necessary, and maintain in force in the flood zone, adequate land use, control measures and enforcement provisions consistent with the requirements of the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations. The Commission further approved revisions to Tuscaloosa County's Flood Damage Prevention Ordinance, which was originally adopted June 13, 2001.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted three to one to approve the submission of an application for a 2007 Community Development Block Grant for the extension of sanitary sewer in the Culver Road/Johnson Road area. This project, estimated at \$998,605.32 including \$598,605.32 in local cash match, will provide sanitary sewer to approximately eighty-five households. Commissioner Bobby Miller cast the NAY vote.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving the use of local matching funds for the connection of all qualified residential housing units to the proposed sanitary sewer Community Development Block Grant project on Culver Road/Johnson Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare the old kitchen equipment removed from the County Jail during renovation as surplus. This action will facilitate disposal of said equipment.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for Electronic Monitoring Services and Equipment for the Tuscaloosa County Community Corrections Office to Group 4 Justice Services. The bids were opened April 18, 2007.

Upon request by Mr. C.L. Hendrix, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the roads in Rue Acres Subdivision, Phase II, for maintenance by Tuscaloosa County, contingent upon Mr. Hendrix providing documentation from contractor Harold Appling that he (Appling) brought said roads up to county specifications in 2001 or 2002.


Upon request by Ms. Toni Franklin, Director of United Cerebral Palsy of West Alabama, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to appropriate \$25,000 to assist with the installation of a state-of-the-art rubberized "Pour in Place" surface for a proposed fully-accessible community playground and park. This self-draining, little or no maintenance, surface will allow full access for children or adults using walkers, crutches, or wheelchairs to play or visit in the park.

Ms. Connie McCool presented a petition containing approximately three hundred signatures requesting that the County Commission provide funding for five (5) deputies for the 2007-2008 school year in order to maintain the School Resource Officer Program. Ms. McCool stated that the deputies' presence in the schools is important to provide discipline and safety. The petition is on file in the Commission Office.




There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, May 16, 2007.

## RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, certain areas of Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, are subject to periodic flooding, mudslides (i.e. mudflows), or flood-related erosion, causing serious damage to properties within these areas; and

WHEREAS, relief is available in the form of federally subsidized flood insurance as authorized by the National Flood Insurance Act of 1968; and

WHEREAS, it is the intent of the Tuscaloosa County Commission to require the recognition and evaluation of flood, mudslide (i.e. mudflow) or flood losses pursuant to Code of Alabama 1975, as amended, Sections 11-19-1, et seq.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Tuscaloosa County Commission hereby:

1. Assures the Federal Insurance Administration that it will enact as necessary, and maintain in force those areas having flood, mudslide ( i.e. mudflow), or flood-related erosion hazards, adequate land use and control measures with effective enforcement provisions consistent with the Criteria set forth in CFR 44, Part 60.3 of the National Flood Insurance Program Regulations; and
2. Vests the Tuscaloosa County Department of Planning and Community Development, with the responsibility, authority, and means to :
  - a. Assist the Administrator, at his request, in his delineation of the limits of the area having special flood, mudslide (i.e. mudflow), or flood related erosion hazards.
  - b. Provide such information as the Administrator may request concerning present uses and occupancy of the floodplain, mudslide (i.e. mudflow), or flood-related erosion areas.
  - c. Cooperate with Federal, State and local agencies and private firms which undertake to study, survey, map and identify floodplain, mudslides (i.e. mudflow) or flood related erosion areas, and cooperate with neighboring communities with respect to management of adjoining floodplain, mudslide (i.e. mudflow) and/or flood related erosion areas to prevent aggravation of existing hazards.
  - d. Submit on the anniversary date of the community's initial eligibility an annual report to the Administrator on the progress made during the past year within the community in the development and implementation of floodplain management measures.
  - e. Upon occurrence, notify the Administrator in writing whenever the boundaries of the community have been modified by annexation or the community has otherwise assumed or no longer has authority to adopt and enforce floodplain management regulations for a particular area.

In order that all Flood Hazard Boundary Maps and Flood Insurance Rate Maps accurately represent the community's boundaries, include within such notification a copy of a map of the community suitable for reproduction, clearly delineating the new corporate limits or new area for which the community has assumed or relinquished floodplain management regulatory authority.

3. Appoints the Tuscaloosa County Department of Planning and Community Development to maintain for public inspection and to furnish upon request, for the determination of applicable flood insurance risk premium rates within all areas having special flood hazards identified on a Flood Hazard Boundary Map or Flood Insurance Rate Map, any certificates of flood-proofing, and information on the elevation (in relation to mean sea level) of the level of the lowest habitable floor (including basement if habitable) of all new or substantially improved structures, and include whether or not such structures contain a basement; and if the structure has been floodproofed, the elevation (in relation to mean sea level) to which the structure was floodproofed.
4. Agrees to take such other official action as may be necessary to carry out the objectives of the program. Notwithstanding the provisions herein, no action shall be required without adequate funding sources for cost related to the program including, but not limited to, the costs for mapping and elevation determination.

R E S O L U T I O N

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission is eligible to apply for grant funds under the **Community Development Block Grant Program** as administered by the Alabama Department of Economic and Community Affairs; and

WHEREAS, two public hearings were held to solicit input from county residents regarding various proposed eligible projects under the grant program; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the proposed projects, the determination has been made that there exists a need for the extension of sanitary sewer in the **Culver Road/Johnson Road area** to eliminate the use of poorly-functioning septic tanks and to alleviate potential health threats through the provision of an adequate and acceptable means for the disposal of sanitary waste;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tuscaloosa County Commission hereby approves the preparation and submission of an application for a **2007 Community Development Block Grant Project** requesting a portion of the funds required for the extension of sanitary sewer into the aforementioned area to serve approximately 85 households at a total cost of approximately \$998,605.32 (grant funds and local matching funds);

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that \$598,605.32 in the form of cash match will be provided by the Tuscaloosa County Commission as a statement of local commitment to the project and that W. Hardy McCollum, Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute all required documents related to the submission of the application.
