This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize payment to Alabama Power Company for relocation of power poles and associated facilities to accommodate improvements to Herman Boyd Road, Hatter Road, and Jones Cutoff Road.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a material option with Price Construction at \$1.50 per cubic yard for a period of June 21, 2007, through July 12, 2007. The pit is located on Hurricane Road.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a road bore on Ed Stephens Road at a cost of approximately \$17,387 to accommodate installing water lines for the new Road and Bridge camp, which is being moved from Hargrove Road.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve payment of \$13,526 to Burk-Kleinpeter, Inc. for professional services performed on the Patriot Parkway Extension Project through the month of April, 2007.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider adopting a resolution accepting the streets in Sandy Creek Phase Two Subdivision.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution accepting the streets, together with the drainage structures in, and which are a part of, said streets which are located in dedicated street rights-of-way, in Sandy Creek Phase Two Subdivision for maintenance by the Tuscaloosa County Commission.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a 25 MPH speed limit on the gravel portion of Riverbend Road (Simpson Swamp Road).

Upon recommendation by Evans Fitts with Fitts Architects and the County Attorney, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the base bid for construction of a new Tuscaloosa County Public Works Department office building and a welding shop in the amount of \$1,770,000.00 to Bill Lunsford Construction, Inc.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to depart from the order of business set forth in the official agenda to consider approving the annual report presented by Tax Collector Peyton Cochrane.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the "Insolvents, Errors and Taxes in Litigation for 2006 and Uncollected Insolvents and Taxes in Litigation for Previous Year(s) as presented by Tax Collector Peyton Cochrane.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to provide fifty percent of the estimated cost of \$55,300 to expand the Englewood-Hulls Water System to serve existing residences along Frierson Road. The county's commitment of approximately \$27,650 will be funded by District III's discretionary paving monies.

Exhibit 6-9, Pages 79-80

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to add Phillips Drive to the previously approved Lucille Drive Water Extension Project in conjunction with Citizens Water System, which would increase the estimated cost of the project serving 11 families by approximately \$11,000 for a total project cost of \$35,000. The county's commitment of 50% of the cost would be approximately \$17,500, with the balance funded by Citizens Water System and residents in the area. Due to this project being declared an emergency, the Commission waived the bid requirements to allow

a minimum of three proposals to be obtained for the construction cost, pending approval by Citizens Water System.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the month of May, 2007.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a waiver of Rule 5-3-6 of Tuscaloosa County's Subdivision Regulations for Taylorville Crossing Subdivision. This action will allow lots in a cul-de-sac to have 20 feet of road frontage in lieu of the minimum of 30 feet as stated in Rule 5-3-6.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant William Godwin, Manager of Duncanville Wetlands LLC and owner of GFC Construction, permission to place sanitary sewer lines for a new privately-owned wastewater treatment plant along county rights-of-way on Bear Creek Road, between the plant site and the new Duncanville Middle School, which is scheduled to open in 2008. The Commission will develop a policy regarding sewer lines and rights-of-way before granting Mr. Godwin permission to move forward on other sewer lines that will service about 4,500 homes and businesses in the Duncanville area.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid opened on May 16, 2007, for "Software and Implementation Services for Integrated Financial System" to CSI Technology Outfitters.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to endorse the concept of appointing a committee to work with various groups and/or agencies to develop a county-wide plan for water and sewer.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution exercising the option to join with the state in


exempting certain items from sales and use taxes during a State Sales Tax Holiday (August 3rd, 4th, and 5th, 2007) as provided by Act 2006-574 enacted by the Alabama Legislature.




Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to shut down Road and Bridge Department operations the week of July 2, 2007, through July 6, 2007, in conjunction with the July 4th holiday. The employees will take four days of leave time and receive one paid holiday. This action was taken due to a high number of employees already taking leave time and the holiday falling in the middle of the week.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to set the County Commission's next regular meeting date as July 11, 2007. The Commission will not meet on July 4th due to the holiday, nor July 18th due to a conflict with the NACO Conference.

Know all men by these presents that and in consideration of one dollar (\$1.00) in hand paid to the undersigned, receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, the undersigned Owner(s) or authorized representative(s) of mineral and surface rights of a certain tract of land hereinafter described, do(es) hereby grant unto TUSCALOOSA COUNTY, acting through the Tuscaloosa County Public Works Department, or its contractor, the right to remove such quantities of the above indicated material as desired for use in the land, hereinafter described, together with the use of whatever lands are necessary for a convenient temporary right of way between this tract of land and the Project for the duration of this instrument: said tract being approximately described as follows: See Attached

Parcel Number: 30-02-03-4-001.002

On which land the definite location of the material to be removed has been designated to the undersigned; under the following conditions, to wit: Payment for the material removed from the above described land shall be at the rate of \$ 1.50 per cubic yard by loose volume in the same manner as payment to the County's hauling contractor(s) or agent(s) and that payment shall be made to the undersigned by the County or its contractor(s), within thirty (30) days after the expiration of each calendar month in which this material was removed, and it is hereby agreed that no payment shall be made to the undersigned for any stripping or material necessarily removed in securing suitable material. The County or its contractor(s) will remove without charge any or all such stripping or material to any spot on the land designated by the undersigned, within three hundred (300) feet of the place of excavation, and that the above payment will compensate the undersigned in full for any damages to the land incurred in the removal and disposal of these materials.

This option to purchase the right to remove materials in accordance with the terms of this instrument shall be binding upon the undersigned, the undersigned heirs, assigns, or administrators from the date of its execution for a period of June 21, 2007 thru July 12, 2007.

The undersigned authorized representative(s) hereby further state(s) that they have the right to give this option and to sell the said material and that the said land (pit) is free and clear of all liens, mortgages, encumbrances and/or reservations.

In exchange for this exclusive agreement, Tuscaloosa County agrees to undertake to acquire and maintain, during the term of this agreement, all necessary permits from the Alabama Department of Environmental Management.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION:
