This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid that meets specifications for a 42" Color Scanner for the Engineering Department. Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve Change Order No. 1 to Tuscaloosa County's contract with Bill Lunsford Construction and Development for a new Public Works Office Building and Welding Shop. The change order is an addition of \$73,673.68 for work to the Office Building.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the Engineering Department to seek bids for nine (9) 2008 Model Pickup Trucks to be utilized by Supervisors.

The County Commission authorized the County Engineer to seek bids to replace a tractor destroyed by vandals; and to acquire a trailer for the bridge crew's welding machine and an air conditioner for the yard crane.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence to proceed with acquiring the necessary right-of-way for the Duncanville Middle School access road.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a 35 MPH speed limit on Tabernacle Road from Hwy 171 to Brownville Pike.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve the warrants issued to cover Tuscaloosa County's expenditures for the month of August, 2007.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to continue operating under the budget for fiscal year 2006-2007 until the Commission adopts a budget for fiscal year 2007-2008.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant Accounting Manager William Lamb's request to loan the Road and Bridge Fund \$700,000 from the General Fund.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid to replace the locks at the Tuscaloosa County Jail to Corrections Products Company. The bids were opened September 5, 2007.

The one bid received for Ambulance Services Provided to the Tuscaloosa County Jail, from NorthStar EMS, Inc., was opened and referred to the Sheriff's Office for appropriate action.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Tom Joiner to fill the unexpired term of James Cain as a joint City of Tuscaloosa/Tuscaloosa County member of the City of Tuscaloosa/Tuscaloosa County Port Authority.

Amelia Heath, Executive Director of FOCUS on Senior Citizens, and three board members of FOCUS presented the Commission with information on the services provided by the agency in 2006.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to establish and post a 25 MPH speed limit on Shamblin Road from Hwy 171 to Faucett Drive.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to retain the two existing Homeland Security grant deputy positions as Civil Service deputy positions.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to appoint Gary McCracken to fill the unexpired term of Tommy Wood on the Fosters/Ralph Water Authority. This term will expire March 1, 2011.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize County Attorney Robert Spence and Attorney Barry Mullins to proceed with acquiring the necessary right-of-way for Phase I of the County Road 2 Extension Project. This 5.5 mile extension would connect to U.S. 82 at Upper Columbus Road and extend to County Road 2 at Boothtown Road to tie into a proposed new school site. This phase of the project is estimated to cost approximately \$5.6 million.



Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to award





The following bid is for contract Ambulance services provided to the Tuscaloosa County Jail for inmate transport to the hospital and other such health organizations as needed.

Bid will be for *basic transportation only* for emergency and non-emergency situations where the ambulance must come to the County Jail and transport sick or injured inmates to the hospital or other medical facility for medical treatment. *Addition emergency medical treatment provided by the ambulance company is not included in this bid.*

Ambulance companies must be capable of supplying the following:


1. **EMERGENCY SERVICES** - Emergency transportation, emergency medical treatment, and emergency medical aid to the sick, ill, injured, or wounded.
2. **ADVANCED LIFE SUPPORT, or ALS.** The treatment of potentially life-threatening medical emergencies through the use of invasive medical techniques specified as advanced life support techniques by the State Board of Health, which ordinarily would be performed or provided by licensed physicians, but which may be performed or provided by emergency technicians during emergencies under constraints specified by rule of the Board.
3. Each shall be equipped with at least one monitor defibrillator and shall be licensed pursuant to the provisions of ALA. CODE §22-18-1, et seq, as amended, and shall comply with the rules and regulations issued pursuant thereto to provide the I.V. fluid/drug supply/re-supply program.
4. Each shall be equipped to provide advanced airway maintenance.
5. Each shall be quipped with a 12-lead EKG instrument capable of sending data via telephone lines and via cellular telephones.
6. Each ambulance company shall be staffed on a twenty-four (24) hour, seven (7) day per week basis.
7. Ambulances will be operated by no less than one emergency medical technician - paramedic, and one emergency medical technician - basic/driver.
8. Ambulance companies must respond from a location within five (5) miles of the Tuscaloosa County Jail.


