

TUSCALOOSA COUNTY COMMISSION
MEETING

October 17, 2007

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Don Wallace
Gary Youngblood
Reginald Murray

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Don Wallace, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant the one-time lump sum payment to Tuscaloosa County retirees provided for under the provisions of Act 2007-257. Retirees will receive the payment totaling \$1.00 for each month that they worked under the Retirement Systems of Alabama.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for traffic striping on various roads throughout Tuscaloosa County to Ozark Striping Co., Inc. The bids were opened October 3, 2007.

Upon recommendation by County Engineer Bobby Hagler, and upon motion by Commissioner Don Wallace, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for water line relocation on Barrettown Road, Jones Cutoff Road, and Hatter Road to TKE, LLC in the amount of \$126,535.10.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award

the bid for a Hewlett Packard Scanner to Tuscaloosa Blueprinting and Reprographics, Inc. The bids were opened September 19, 2007.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications for reinforcing steel. Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to nominate James W. Price and Jim Kennedy to be considered by the State of Alabama Department of Revenue as Tuscaloosa County's appointee on the County Board of Equalization.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineer and Public Works Department to assist the City of Northport with the relocation of an 1882 bridge from New Lexington to Northport.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to reimburse Buhl, Elrod and Holman Water Authority \$21,325 for engineering fees for the Barrettown Road, Jones Cutoff Road, and Hatter Road water line relocation project. This is a waiver of Tuscaloosa County's policy requiring water authorities/systems to pay for engineering fees associated with water line relocations. This cost will be funded from District I road construction funds.

Commissioner Don Wallace moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution approving the submission of an application for a Transportation Enhancement Program Grant requesting a portion of the funds required for the proposed Northside Community Sidewalk Safety Project. The approximate cost of the project is \$345,385.00, including \$70,000 local cash match and an additional \$30,034 of required local funds for engineering design costs.



Prudes Mill Road (approaching the entrances to Davis-Emerson Middle School)


Keenes Mill Road (approaching the STOP sign)

62nd Avenue (approaching Gordon Davis Park)


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, November 7, 2007.

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS, the Tuscaloosa County Commission is eligible to apply for grant funds under the **Transportation Enhancement Program (2008)** as administered by the State of Alabama Department of Transportation; and


WHEREAS, a proposed project, **The Northside Community Sidewalk/Safety Project**, would improve and enhance pedestrian safety through the construction of sidewalks along County Road 38 and the surrounding area in the vicinity of Walker Elementary School, Northside Middle School and Northside High School; and

WHEREAS, upon review of the proposed project, the determination has been made that there is a need for the proposed project to eliminate existing safety hazards and concerns for students, area residents and vehicular traffic in this area of Tuscaloosa County;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tuscaloosa County Commission hereby approves the preparation and submission of an application for a **Transportation Enhancement Program Grant**, requesting a portion of the funds required for the proposed project, in the aforementioned area for a total cost of approximately **\$345,385.00** (Grant funds and local matching funds);

BE IT FUTHER RESOLVED that **\$70,000.00** in the form of cash match will be provided by the Tuscaloosa County Commission as a statement of local commitment to the project and that W. Hardy McCollum, Chairman, is hereby authorized to execute all required documents related to the submission of the application.
