Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to amend the contract time for Perma Corporation on the West Area Project of Tuscaloosa County's 2002 Water Systems Expansion Program on Robertson Road, Roberts Road, and Preacher Lee Road. This time extension of twenty-one days is due to excessive rain in early Spring.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to renew the Tax Revenue Enhancement Agreement with AlaTax, Inc. for three years. Under this agreement, AlaTax, Inc. collects tobacco tax and any other taxes designated by Tuscaloosa County.

The bids were opened April 9, 2003.






1. Waiver for the size of a lot on an easement from three acres to one acre.

3. Vary the width of an easement from 30 feet to 25 feet for the first 339 feet of easement.





Tax Revenue Enhancement Agreement

This agreement made as of the ____ day of _____, by and between AlaTax, Inc., a Delaware corporation ("AlaTax") and Tuscaloosa County, Alabama, an Alabama COUNTY ("COUNTY").

A. Remittance Processing Services

1. Taxes Processed: AlaTax will perform remittance processing for tobacco and any other taxes designated by COUNTY.
2. Taxpayer Notification and Remittance: AlaTax will send individualized tax forms to all known taxpayers. Taxpayers will remit payments to Tuscaloosa County, P.O. Box 830725, Birmingham, AL 35283-0725. Upon reasonable notice to COUNTY, AlaTax may change the P.O. Box for Tuscaloosa County payments.
3. Deposit Process: Deposits are made to the extent that funds have been received, via Automated Clearing House of the amounts required by law to the designated recipients as instructed by the COUNTY in accordance with the law providing for each type of tax collected.
4. Posting Process: Taxpayer accounts are posted with payment information captured in the AlaTax revenue system. Additional information such as net sales, deductions, credit sales, measure of tax, name change and address change are captured and added to payment data and taxpayer master file (as determined necessary by AlaTax). Late payments (postmarked by U.S. Postal Service after due date) are invoiced at penalty amounts required by State code. Under payments are invoiced for remaining tax due plus any required penalties.
5. Notification, Reporting to COUNTY:
 - i. AlaTax will provide COUNTY with monthly reports including, but not limited to, payment listings showing all taxes received, printout related to net receipts reported, a general ledger distribution that corresponds to COUNTY'S account numbers and all fees paid to AlaTax. These reports to be provided by the 10th of the month following the tax month;
 - ii. AlaTax will attend Commission meetings at such times as may be reasonably requested by COUNTY.

B. Compliance Services

1. Taxes Reviewed: AlaTax will perform compliance services for sales, use and other taxes designated by COUNTY under Remittance Processing Services. AlaTax will provide delinquency notification and follow-up. This includes correspondence, calls, and collection procedures and the related documentation. Delinquency policies and procedures will be applied consistently and within all applicable tax laws.
2. Conduct of Compliance Services: To assure that all taxpayers are treated fairly and consistently and all compliance services are performed in a similar manner, AlaTax representatives who perform compliance services will use a similar compliance plan for each compliance service conducted. All funds due from compliance services will be remitted to COUNTY in the same manner as provided for pursuant to Section A.3 above.

C. General Provisions

1. Taxpayer service: AlaTax will provide a taxpayer assistance number for taxpayer questions. AlaTax will provide informational brochures for placement in COUNTY offices, Chamber of Commerce offices, libraries and any other facilities. This information will also be available on the Internet at www.alatax.com.

2. Review and Appeal Process: AlaTax has adopted and will use a review and appeals process which is based on the Alabama Taxpayers' Bill of Rights Act and Uniform Revenue Procedures Act codified as Title 40, Chapter 2A, Code of Alabama, 1975, as amended.
3. Consideration for Remittance Processing Services, Revenue Analysis Services and Compliance Services: AlaTax will receive an amount equal to Two Dollars and Fifty Cents (\$2.50) per account per transaction for providing Remittance Processing Services and Revenue Analysis Services.
4. Audit Services:
 - i. AlaTax Audit Services: Audit Services include all preparation for the performance of an audit, any research or statistical analysis performed in relation to an audit, examination of the books and records of the taxpayer, an assessment of the amount due (if any), and all services related to closing an audit.
 - ii. AlaTax Fee: AlaTax will receive an amount based on an hourly rate of sixty dollars (\$60) for audit services, without any contingent fees whatsoever. If overnight travel outside the State of Alabama is required, AlaTax will pay the auditor, and bill the COUNTY for its portion of travel expenses. COUNTY agrees to pay the amount of these fees when due, regardless of any recovery.
 1. Billing Increment: Time will be recorded in 15-minute intervals (.25 hours);
 2. Shared Audit Fees: When audits for COUNTY overlap with audits for other AlaTax clients or clients of AlaTax Affiliates, the fees will be shared as follows:
 - a. Travel Time: travel time, expenses, and a daily per diem amount for each audit is distributed evenly among the clients reviewed for each audit.
 - b. Interview Time: time billed during the initial interview of each audit is distributed evenly amongst the clients reviewed for each audit – during this process the auditor determines which clients will actually be audited for and billed Audit Time as follows:
 - i. Audit Time: time billed during the actual audit stage of each audit is billed according to actual time spent working for each client;
 - ii. No Double Billing: In no event will the overlapping audits combined require payment for more than 100% for any one AlaTax representative.
5. Company Audit: Once a year AlaTax will have an auditor prepare an Independent Service Auditor's Report on Controls Placed in Operation and Tests of Operating Effectiveness. This report is commonly called a SAS 70 Type II report and will be made available upon request.
6. Term of the Agreement: This agreement shall be for a term of three years following the date of execution. Either party shall have the right to terminate this Agreement in the event of a material breach by the other party. Any such termination may be made only by providing ninety (90) days written notice to the other party, specifically identifying the breach or breaches on which termination is based. Following receipt of such notice, the party in breach shall have thirty (30) days to cure such breach or breaches. In the event that such cure is not made, this Agreement shall terminate in accordance with the initial ninety (90) days notice.
7. Indemnity: To the full extent allowed by law, COUNTY hereby agrees to indemnify and hold AlaTax harmless from any claims and against all costs, expenses, damages, claims and liabilities, relating to the determination of taxes due from taxpayers, the collection thereof and any refunding related thereto.

- 8. Entire Agreement: This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties hereto and supersedes any prior understandings or written or oral agreements between the parties respecting the subject matter contained herein. Said Agreement shall not be amended, altered, or changed, except by a written Agreement signed by both parties hereto.
- 9. Invalidity: If any one or more of the provisions contained in this Agreement shall for any reason be held to be invalid, illegal, or unenforceable in any respect, such invalidity, illegality, or unenforceability shall not affect any other provision thereof, and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained thereof, and this Agreement shall be construed as if such invalid, illegal, or unenforceable provision had never been contained herein.
- 10. Effective Date: The effective date for the performance of services under the terms of this agreement shall commence _____ 1, 20__ with collection of _____ taxes to be remitted on or before _____ 20, 20__.

Re: Waiver Request – Tommy Corkerin Subdivision

Dear Mr. Chairman and Members of the Commission:

Attached you will find a copy of a one-lot subdivision as proposed by McPherson Surveying Company. Mr. Tommy Corkerin is the owner of record. This subdivision is located in District 1, East of U.S. Highway 43 and approximately one (1) mile North of the intersection with Tuscaloosa County Road No. 38.

They are proposing to extract a 1.00 parcel acre out of a 19.9-acre tract of land for residential purposes by using a 30 foot-wide easement (initially 25 feet wide) as access to the newly created lot from said Highway 43.

Mr. Corkerin and McPherson Surveying Company are requesting the following waivers from the subdivision requirements:

- 1) The requirement that any newly created parcel of land (that is to use a private access easement) must have a minimum area of 3.00 acres or more.
- 2) The requirement that any newly created access easement must less than 1200 feet in length.
- 3) The requirement that any newly created access easement must be 30 feet in width, minimum.

Rule 5-4-12(b)(1) states in regards to use of Private Access Easements, “Lots or parcels must be three (3.00) acres in size or greater.”

Rule 5-4-12(b)(2) states in regards to use of Private Access Easements, “Lots or parcels of land using a common access easement ... such easement shall not be greater than twelve hundred (1200) feet in length.”

Rule 5-4-12(b)(3) states in regards to use of Private Access Easements, **“Easements to said parcels must be thirty (30) feet in width, minimum.”** The proposed subdivision (as depicted) indicates use of a newly created 25-foot wide easement at its beginning and running for about 339 feet. At that point, the easement widens to become thirty (30) feet in width.

Also, the easement (as proposed) has two (2) immediate (and reverse) 90° turns in it, which is not conducive to proper traffic flow. Over time, it is assumed that the vehicles would “cut the corners” off as they traveled along the road, thus creating encroachments onto the adjoining property owners.

After a review of the proposed subdivision, this office recommends that you deny these subdivision waiver requests.
