Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for earthwork on William Kelly, Gilliam, and Fondren Roads to the low bidder meeting specifications. Bidding firms were as follows:

Upon request from the Alabama Department of Transportation, and upon motion by Commissioner Mike Richardson, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the contractor constructing the access ramp linking Mitt Lary Road and State Hwy 171 to work on county right-of-way.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the disbursement of \$15,000 of Senator Poole's discretionary funds to the City of Tuscaloosa for the installation of traffic lights in Alberta City.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the disbursement of \$4,000 of Senator Phil Poole's discretionary funds to the Town of Brookwood to assist Brookwood's Police Department.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to declare the Sheriff's Office's 1972 Cessna 182 surplus property. The Sheriff's Office will dispose of this plane and purchase a later model.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the Sheriff's Office's selection of Ritz Camera as the low bidder meeting specifications for seventy-five digital cameras. The bids were opened July 30, 2003.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the Sheriff's Office's selection of Sirchie Finger Print Laboratories, Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications for a reflective ultraviolet imaging system. The bids were opened July 30, 2003.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of three change orders on contracts covering renovation of the basement in the Tuscaloosa County Courthouse. The changes are as follows: Tuscaloosa Acoustical- an increase of \$642; Russell S. Lee Floor and Tile - an increase of \$2,814; and Reco, Inc. - an increase of \$4,895.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Mr. Ed Barrett \$3,600 to relocate three tenths miles of fence on one side of Malone Creek Road, adjacent to Mr. Barrett's property. The county's estimate, using county forces, is greater than the \$3,600 offer made by Mr. Barrett.




Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize a payment of \$800 each to property owners Mr. Doyle Pendley and Ms. Rebecca Gilliam for right-of-way adjacent to Halcomb Road. This purchase of right-of-way is to facilitate the construction of a bridge over a tributary of Freeman Creek.


Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to pay Mr. Rayburn Swindle \$1,500 for material (dirt) used to base North Swindle Road. The material was purchased from Mr. Swindle because of convenience to the road project.


Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to reappoint Ms. Linda Mason to the Buhl, Elrod and Holman Water Authority. This new term began on March 1, 2003, and expires March, 2009.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, August 13, 2003.
