This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a revised resolution agreeing to all of the requirements of any agreement in regard to a state-funded bridge replacement project consisting of the construction of a bridge over Bee Branch on Canyon Lake Road, which is included in the Tuscaloosa County Road System. The efficiency ratings in the original resolution adopted June 18, 2003, were incorrect.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to approve a thirty day (addition) change order on the Progress Drive extension in association with the Johnson Controls Project.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the execution of a "Certificate of Approval" approving the issuance of bonds for the following two (2) projects:

1. INTERSTATE PROPERTIES PROJECT - \$2,600,000 for the purpose of acquiring a 6.57 acre site located at 2992 Interstate Circle, Cottondale, Alabama, and to construct a 33,034 square foot building for the purpose of manufacturing, assembling, and distributing automotive service parts and related products.




Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to request the Alabama Legislature to pass legislation that would allow the County Commission to hold a referendum that would give the Commission zoning powers in the planning jurisdiction of all governmental units within Tuscaloosa County. Only those citizens living within said planning jurisdiction will be eligible to vote this legislation up or down.


Upon request by Chief Deputy Ron Abernathy, and upon motion by Commissioner Reginald Murray, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to eliminate the medical personnel funding from the Tuscaloosa County Jail's 2003-2004 budget and use these funds to fund four additional Sergeant positions at the jail. This action will not require any new hires; promotions will be made from available personnel. Commissary funds will be used to supplement any shortage of funds to pay for these four promotions.


Upon request from Mr. Roscoe Kornegay, and upon motion by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to assist the Vance Volunteer Fire Department by providing some of the concrete needed to construct a slab for their new fire department.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, January 7, 2004.
