This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presented License Commission Chief Clerk Dorothy Collins a twenty-five year service pin and thanked her for her dedicated service to the citizens of Tuscaloosa County.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the County Engineer's selection of Alabama Gate City Steel as the low bidder meeting specifications for reinforcing steel. The bids were opened April 21, 2004.

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to concur with the County Engineer's selection of Tomlin Construction as the low bidder meeting specifications for earthwork on John Swindle Road. The bids were opened April 7, 2004.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to adopt a resolution agreeing to enter into a Traffic Signal Maintenance Agreement with the State of Alabama for a flashing school signal at the intersection of Highway 69S and Southview Lane (commonly referred to as Bobby Miller Parkway) Northeast of Englewood - Project No. STPHS-0069(506).

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications for assembly hardware (bridge components). Bidding firms were as follows:

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to increase the county-wide water project's budget and to award the bid for the Southwest (Brown Oak Drive, 68th Street, and Johnson Road) Tuscaloosa Project to John Plott Company, Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications. The \$168,430.02 bid exceeded the estimate by \$24,430.

Commissioner Reginald Murray's motion to erect road name signs county-wide on all county roads failed for lack of a second.


Upon request by Planning Director Farrington Snipes, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize a refund of \$6,500 to the Department of Justice. This represents ten percent of Federal Local Law Enforcement Block Grant Number 1998 LBUX4393. This refund was required because Tuscaloosa County was not in full compliance with the federal public officers benefit program.


Upon request by Planning Director Farrington Snipes, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to amend the Planning Department's budget by transferring \$1,500 from salaries into the overtime account.

There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, May 19, 2004.


