MEETING
June 9, 2004

This being the date and hour to which the Tuscaloosa County Commission adjourned, the County Commission met pursuant to such adjournment with Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum presiding as Chairman. The following members were present:

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to enter into a Road Use Agreement with G.B. "Boots" Smith Corporation. This contractor is hauling water to the methane gas well operation in the Samantha and Yellow Creek areas of Tuscaloosa County. Under this agreement, said contractor will repair any damage to county roads caused by their trucks and equipment.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to execute an agreement (right-of-way permit) with the City of Tuscaloosa. The city will cut Stillman Boulevard twice - five hundred feet and seventy-five feet west of the Southrail-Goodrich Spur. This action facilitates tapping into the existing water main and extending the City of Tuscaloosa's water main inside of Elk Corporation property.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineering Department to purchase mosquito larvicide briquettes, using the State of Alabama's contract, in an effort to reduce the mosquito infestation.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to post Fleetwood Road "NO TRUCKS".

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to execute a material option with Willie Rogers for sand at fifty cents per cubic yard.

Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant Warrior and Associates, Inc. a permit to open-cut Old Cottdale Road to install storm sewer, junction boxes, etc. at 51st Court East.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to award the bid for assembly hardware to Bessemer Fastener as the low bidder meeting specifications. The bids were opened May 5, 2004.

Commissioner Bobby Miller moved, seconded by Commissioner Mike Richardson, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineering Department to fill a well at 12324 Slayton Road in Duncanville. This action is being taken to eliminate a safety hazard.

Bids for the installation of two (2) type 10 end anchors (complete) and one hundred and seventy-five feet of guardrail were opened and referred to the County Engineer for appropriate action. Firms submitting bids were as follows:

Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to accept the low bid meeting specifications for earthwork on three road projects. Bidding firms were as follows:

Upon request by County Attorney Robert Spence, and upon motion by Commissioner Bobby Miller, seconded by Commissioner Gary Youngblood, the County Commission voted unanimously to go into executive session to discuss the Charlie Blount versus Tuscaloosa County lawsuit.

Commissioner Reginald Murray moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to grant a waiver for the first layer of asphalt and base for Harvest Meadows Subdivision roads. This will permit the contractor to finalize the plat before the paving is finished. The curb and gutters have already been installed in the subdivision, but inclement weather has delayed paving the roads. The developer is putting up subdivision lots in lieu of a performance bond.

Upon request by Probate Judge W. Hardy McCollum, and upon motion by Commissioner Mike Richardson, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize Judge McCollum to seek an Attorney General's opinion in regard to a recently passed tobacco tax, if an opinion is deemed necessary to facilitate administering said tobacco tax.


Commissioner Mike Richardson moved, seconded by Commissioner Bobby Miller, the County Commission voted unanimously to authorize the County Engineering Department to determine the best route

and a cost estimate to construct a four-lane highway from Sokol Park to Highway 69N. One of the questions to be answered is: would it be best to construct the proposed four lane down Martin Road or Union Chapel Road, or construct an entirely new road?


Commissioner Gary Youngblood moved, seconded by Commissioner Reginald Murray, the County Commission voted three to one to award the bid for Phase II of the Holt Community Sanitary Sewer Extension Project to Gilco Contracting, Inc. as the low bidder meeting specifications, and to amend the project budget to cover any increase in cost above the original budget. The new budget will reflect the shifting of \$285,000 from the Federal Environmental Protection Agency grant earmarked for the Prudes Creek Water Project to the Holt Sewer Project. The \$285,000 for the Prudes Creek Water Project will be replaced with General Fund monies. Commissioner Gary Youngblood committed \$77,000 to \$80,000 of District II's discretionary funds to assist funding the Holt Sewer Project. The total budget is funded as follows: Environmental Protection Agency grant, \$485,000; Community Development Block Grant, \$500,000; and Tuscaloosa County will provide \$244,891.50 in cash match and \$139,000 in-kind match for a total budget of \$1,368,891.50. Commissioner Mike Richardson cast the NAY vote.

Mr. E. J. Martin presented the County Commission a petition containing one hundred and thirty-six signatures requesting a sewer system for the Holt Community.


There being no further business to come before the Tuscaloosa County Commission, the meeting adjourned to Wednesday, June 23, 2004.





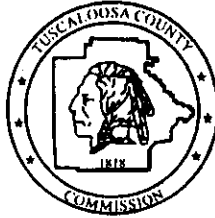

BID SPECIFICATIONS FOR GUARDRAIL AND TYPE 10 END ANCHORS

The Tuscaloosa County Commission will accept bids for the installation of two each (2) Type 10 end anchors (complete) and 170 feet of guardrail. All materials furnished and installation of said materials shall comply with the State of Alabama Department Of Transportation Standard Specifications for Highway Construction, 2002 Edition (hereinafter referred to as the "Specifications") and to the ALDOT Special and Standard Highway Drawings, 2004. Special attention is directed to Section 630 of the Specifications.

All necessary information must be filled in on each bid sheet: Vendor's name and address, date, in the space provided. No bid will be considered unless submitted on these forms.

Work shall begin within fifteen (15) working days after notification by the Tuscaloosa County Engineering Department. Work shall be prosecuted in a continuous manner until completion. In the event that work has not started within fifteen (15) working days and/or work is not prosecuted in a diligent and continuous manner, the bid may be canceled and placed with the bidder whose price is the next acceptable bid above the lowest acceptable bid received. The difference in cost accrued in the change from the bid price to the next acceptable bid price above that of the low bidder, may be charged as liquidated damages to the bidder failing to accomplish the work as described above, except where delays are due to causes beyond the control of the contractor.


